### Pay Your Enrollment Confirmation Deposit

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Paying your enrollment confirmation deposit is an important next step. This deposit will allow you to register for classes and, if you plan to live on campus, will allow for your room assignment to be made. This deposit is not an additional fee—it will be credited to your first semester's tuition bill. It can be paid over the phone by calling the Admissions Office at (207) 834-7600 or online using your Student Center in MaineStreet.

### Upload Your COVID-19 Vaccination Card

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Students who are participating in any on-campus experience must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with a vaccine that is either fully approved by the FDA, approved under the FDA emergency use authorization, or approved by the World Health Organization (WHO). Students will need to upload their vaccination card through the UMS COVID-19 Portal here: [umaineportal.pointclick.com](http://umaineportal.pointclick.com). Requests for exemptions are required to be submitted and approved also through the UMS COVID-19 Portal.

### Complete Your Financial Aid Forms

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If you would like to be considered for Federal Financial Aid and you have not submitted your application go to [fasfa.ed.gov](http://fasfa.ed.gov). If you have applied for Federal Financial Aid, keep up to date by making sure you activate your MaineStreet @maine.edu email account and check your Student Center in MaineStreet for all your important student information. Priority filing date is March 31<sup>st</sup> and applications for Financial Aid are accepted starting October 1.

## Send Final Transcripts to the Admissions Office

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If you are currently in high school or currently enrolled in courses at another college, please send us your final academic transcripts when your courses are complete. Final high school transcripts are required for Direct Loans and final college transcripts are required to ensure that your transcript evaluation is complete.

## Complete Immunization Forms & Medical Forms

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All students enrolled in an on-campus program AND students enrolled in an online program who reside in Maine are required to show proof of immunization as well as provide basic medical information for our Health Clinic to have on hand in case of an emergency on campus.
