#### Article 4 - Clearance and risk reduction education

During 2011-2023 it has cleared 33,06 km<sup>2</sup> of CMs contaminated areas and destroyed 23,269 SMs, and released 359 areas through TS with 8,08 km<sup>2</sup> of land released through NTS.

As of December 2023, it has 105 areas identified as contaminated, with 10.18 km<sup>2</sup> of CHAs or SHAs
