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Preface

EIA publishes this report to fulfill data collection and dissemination responsibilities under the Federal Energy Administration Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-275), as amended.

The *Quarterly Coal Report* (QCR) provides information about U.S. coal production, exports, imports, receipts, prices, consumption, quality, stocks, and refined coal data to a wide audience, including Congress, federal and state agencies, the coal industry, and the general public. In addition, the QCR offers U.S. coke production, consumption, stocks, imports, and exports data. The fourth-quarter 2019 QCR includes detailed quarterly coal data for October 2019—December 2019 and aggregated quarterly historical coal data for 2013 through fourth-quarter 2019.

All data for 2018 and previous years are final. All data for 2019 are preliminary.
