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Preface

EIA publishes this report to fulfill data collection and dissemination responsibilities under the Federal Energy Administration Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-275), as amended.

The *Quarterly Coal Report* (QCR) provides information about U.S. coal production, exports, imports, receipts, prices, consumption, quality, stocks, and refined coal data to a wide audience, including Congress, federal and state agencies, the coal industry, and the general public. In addition, the QCR offers U.S. coke production, consumption, stocks, imports, and exports data. The second-quarter 2020 QCR includes detailed quarterly coal data for April 2020 to June 2020 and aggregated quarterly historical coal data for 2014 through second-quarter 2020.

All data for 2019 and previous years are final. All data for 2020 are preliminary.
