We publish this report to fulfill data collection and dissemination responsibilities under the Federal Energy Administration Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-275), as amended.

The *Quarterly Coal Report* (QCR) provides information about U.S. coal production, exports, imports, receipts, prices, consumption, quality, and stocks to a wide audience, including Congress, federal and state agencies, the coal industry, and the general public. In addition, the QCR contains U.S. coke production, consumption, stocks, imports, and exports data. The third-quarter 2023 QCR includes detailed quarterly coal data from July 2023 to September 2023 and aggregated quarterly historical coal data for 2017 through third-quarter 2023.

All data for 2022 and previous years are final. All data for 2023 are preliminary.
