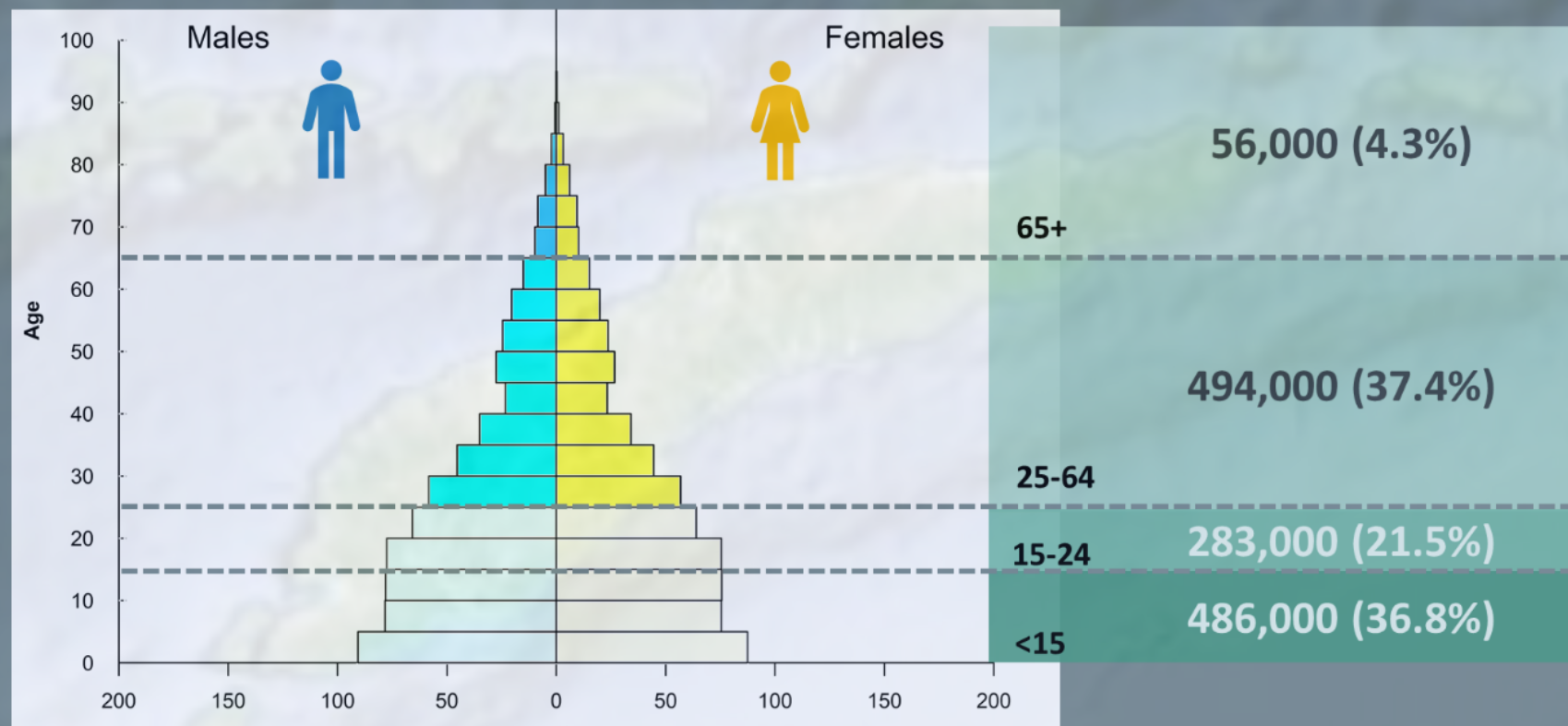

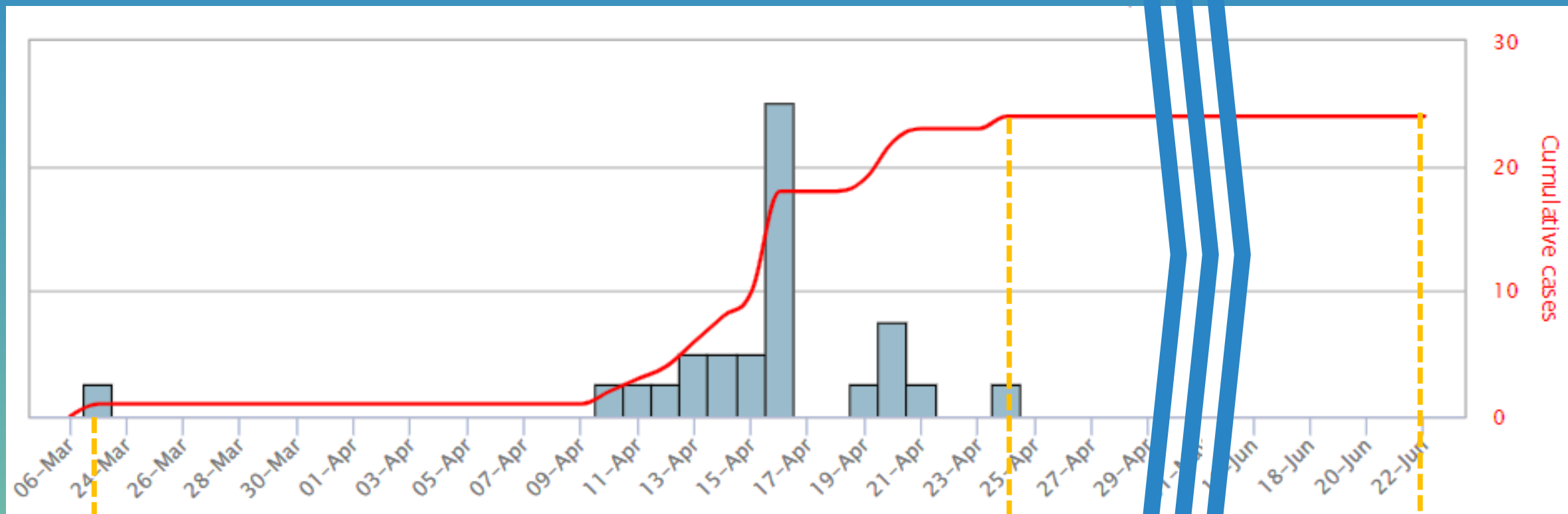

COVID-19 Cases in Timor-Leste, June 22

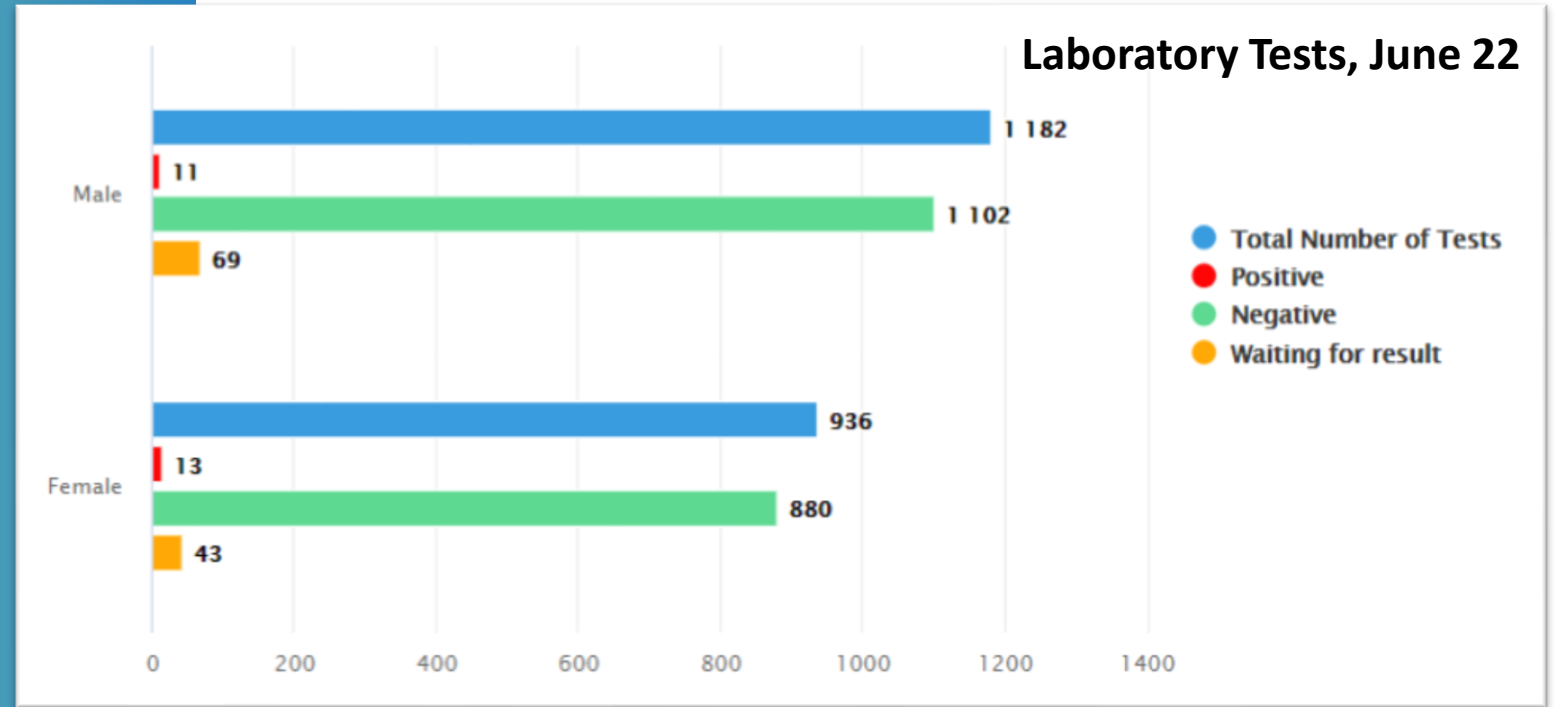


March 21
First confirmed case

3 sporadic cases
21 cluster cases in the quarantine centers

June 22
24 confirmed cases
3,600 people facility quarantined so far

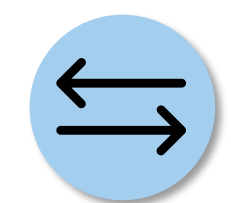

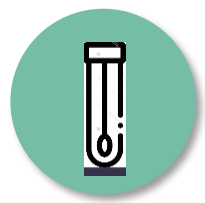

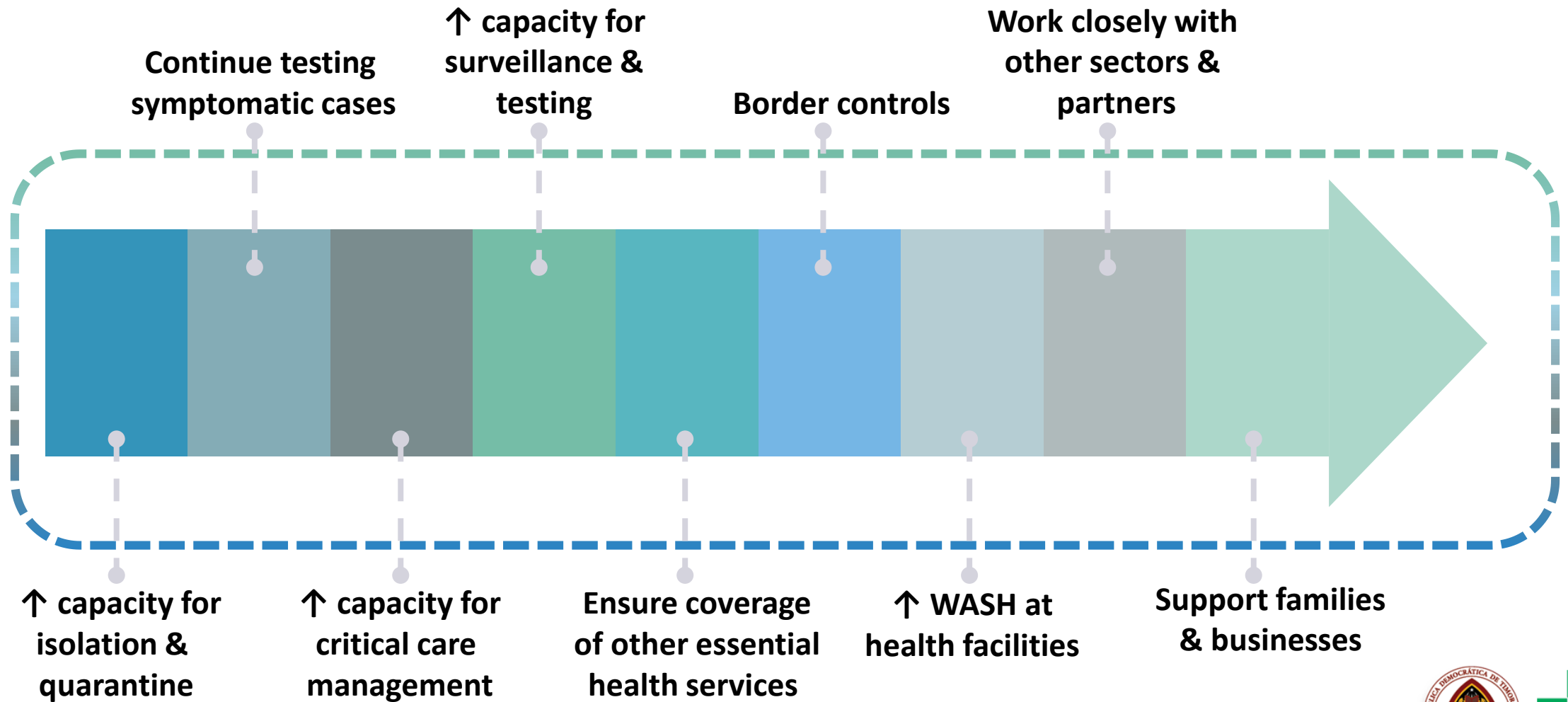
