Agile Member States task group



Mandate:

Decision EB151(1)

Decided:

- (1) to establish an agile Member States task group, open to all Member States, on strengthening WHO budgetary, programmatic and financing governance to analyse challenges in governance for transparency, efficiency, accountability and compliance, and come up with recommendations;
- (2) that the task group would report to the Seventy-sixth World Health Assembly, through the 152nd session of the Executive Board and the thirty-seventh meeting of the Programme, Budget and Administration Committee of the Executive Board in January 2023, to recommend long-term improvements;
- (3) to request the Director-General to convene the first meeting of the task group no later than the first week of July 2022, in order for the task group to determine its methods of work and focus, within the mandate identified by the recommendations of the Working Group on Sustainable Financing.
