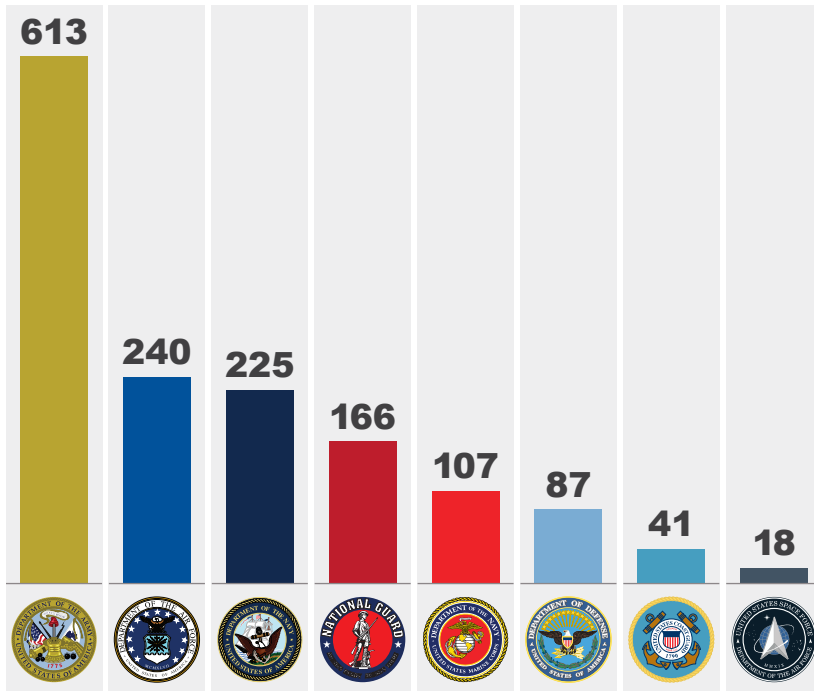




About SPARX Connection
