
John McAuliff:

Here's \$2. For voting complaints all that is needed is signed statements. You should automatically send a copy of every voting complaint to the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights, Washington 25, D.C. They are required by law to investigate every signed voting complaint. However, you should realize that the new civil rights law does not prohibit registrars from giving the voter registration test nor from requiring literacy tests. The sixth grade provision applies only in suits, not in the every day situation.

I have sent the job complaint to the FBI. They have informed us that they will investigate every signed complaint in regard to the new civil rights law.

Keep up your good work. Affidavits are only necessary in cases of police brutality or other ~~special~~ special situations.
