The Executive Secretary is not only chairman of the Executive Committee, but also he has the responsibility to insure that the Committee is actively functioning. Broad, overall plans in the Political, Federal Programs, Economic, welfare, and the Public Relations Spheres are also his responsibility.

The First Vice Chairman is not only ~~is-not-only~~ chairman of the Political Committee, but also he has the responsibility for planning political workshops, voter registration canvassing, mass meetings, etc.

The Second Vice Chairman is not only chairman of the Federal Programs Committee, but also he has the responsibility to see that available programs are used and to see that all who are interested in such programs get the necessary information.

The recording Secretary is responsible for keeping all records, correspondence, and for the general coordination of the Ex. Committee by making sure that each chairman knows what the other is doing by insuring that messages get to whom they are meant.

The Financial Secretary is responsible for both the fund raising and accurate records about the treasury.

The Public Relations Committee Chairman has the responsibility to obtain the cooperation of reluctant ministers, congregations, teachers, and others of influence.

The Welfare Chairman has the responsibility to-obtain for the distribution of welfare materials.
