Dear Dick:

I am enclosing another copy of the memo which has gone out to the staff; you have probably received one already. The staff is being asked to make an all-out effort to recruit college students in their area for the SEDF Field Fellowship program.

This fellowship is a grant of \$250 for the support of the student during the time of the project. So far there has been very little response because, we believe, the students do not know about this program. So we are conducting a last-minute, all-out recruiting drive at the Negro colleges. You are asked to set up a recruitment drive at the colleges in your area. I realize this is very short notice, but it must be done. The deadline for applications has been set at May 31st, which is less than a week away.

I am enclosing a copy of the application form and information about the program; perhaps you have it already. Have the application reproduced and handed out among the college students. There are 60 of these scholarships available; it is very important that we find students to apply for them.

Your efforts will be greatly appreciated--this is an extremely urgent matter. Good luck.
