Your Honor:

We the citizens, The Madison Parish Voters' League and the Congress of Racial Equality petition the Honorable mayor of Tallulah, Louisiana to take prompt action against the water company to supply the Negro Community of Tallulah with fire plugs and a fire station in the vicinity. Because of the lack of fire plugs and the shortage of fire trucks, Mr. Moses Williams lost his Business and two days later a Negro lady lost her life in a tragic fire that destroyed her home.

We demand that direct action be taken within fifteen (15) days to supply fire plugs within the Negro Community and within the next thirty (30) days a Blue Print be ~~drawn~~ drawn up for the Fire Station within the Negro Community.
