I am ashamed of myself for not writing you
before now, but I am a farmer. Every since I have
been back in Mississippi I have been busy
harvesting in my crop - of which I finish a day
after Thanksgiving on Nov 26 - I made only 12 bales
of cotton and the land lord got a 1/4 of that of which
left me only eight (8) bales of cotton the bales of cotton
weight from 500 lb. to 600 lb; Price range from
26 cent per pound. to 30 cent per pound on the grade of
cotton I had. I know you don't know anything about
farming but this is the way of life among most
negroes that live in the south. I know you
you hear from Frank very often I thank
Frank is a nice young man with a vision
