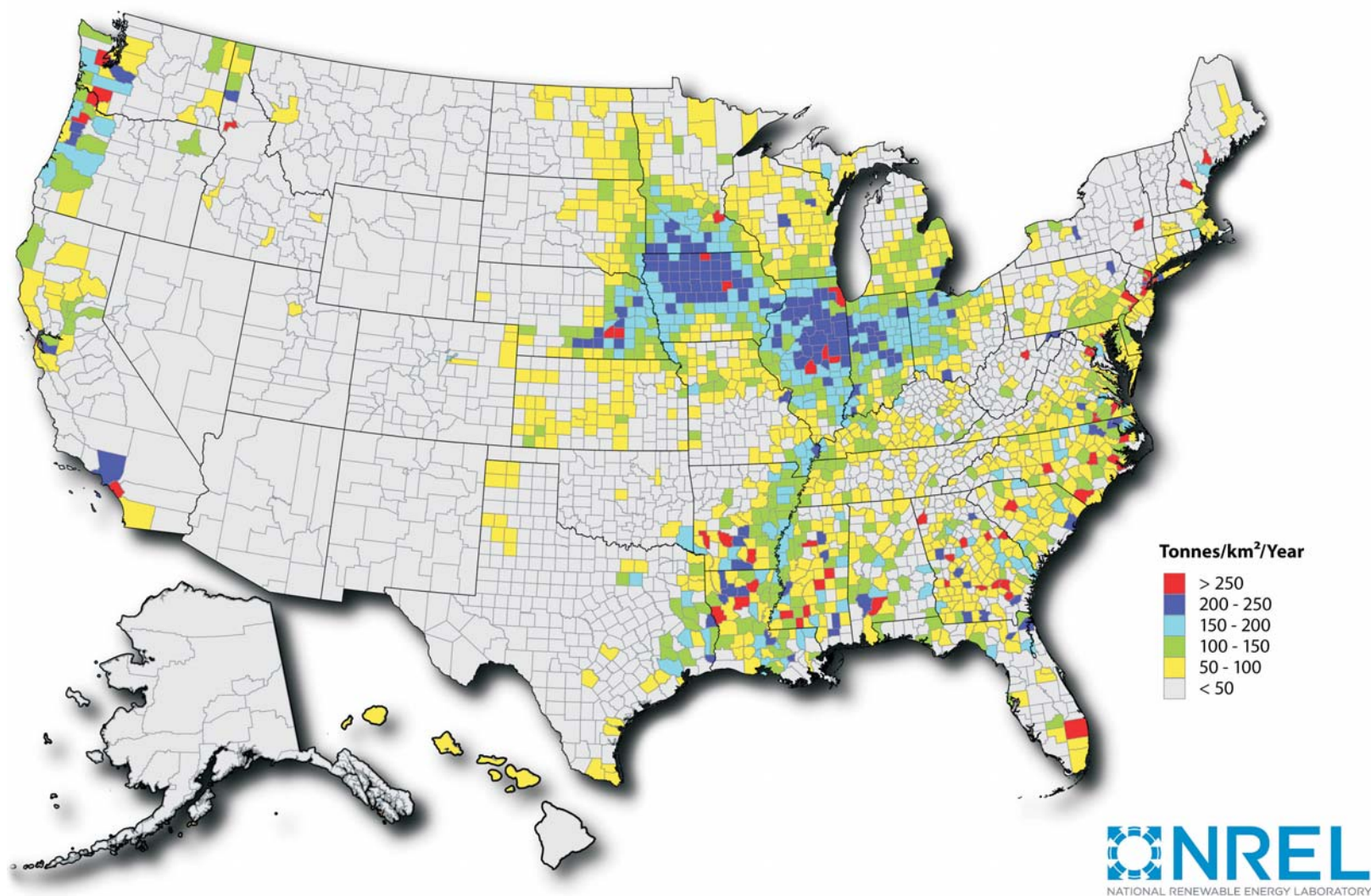


Figure 4.16 Biomass Resources
