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As part of its project funding, the Michigan Primary Care Association contracted with Azara DRVS (Data Reporting and Visualization System) to develop quality measures on preventive and restorative oral health care and to track them, a first for Azara and a significant achievement for the Midwest Network for Oral Health Integration (MNOHI) project. Since the launch of these measures in Azara DRVS, over 65 community health centers in 13 states have implemented the measures. This is a significant step that will help CHCs across the country improve their efforts to integrate oral health care into primary care and provide high-quality oral health care to patients.

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
