



## RoMoNOH Medical-Dental Integration eLearnings

The RoMoNOH project is part of the Networks for Oral Health Integration (NOHI) within the Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Safety Net funded by the Maternal and Child Health Bureau to improve access to and utilization of comprehensive, high-quality oral health care for pregnant women, infants, and children at high risk for oral disease.

RoMoNOH focuses on primary prevention of dental caries in pregnant women and infants and children from birth to age 40 months who are receiving health care in participating community health centers (CHCs) throughout Arizona, Colorado, Montana, and Wyoming.

To facilitate medical practice provider and staff oral health education, as well as their understanding of the HRSA five oral health domains, RoMoNOH created this set of five eLearnings which cover the following: Introduction to Oral Health Integration, Clinical Skills & Integrating Oral Health, Oral Health Communication & Education, Interprofessional Collaboration, and Perinatal Oral Health. Each module takes approximately one hour to complete.

**Even if your practice is not part of the RoMoNOH project you will find these trainings valuable for learning about the basic steps of medical-dental integration in medical settings.**

Following are the instructions for accessing the five eLearning modules. The modules can be accessed anytime, as often as you like.

### Access to CUeLearning modules

1. Go to [CUeLearning.org](http://CUeLearning.org).
2. Choose "Register" and complete the form.
  - a. Your registration code is: OtherOralHealth (not case sensitive; one word, not three).
  - b. After you enter your registration code two more boxes will appear.
    - i. For Organization select "Other".
    - ii. For Role select "Other".
3. You will then be redirected to "My Account" page where you can access the RoMoNOH eLearning modules.
