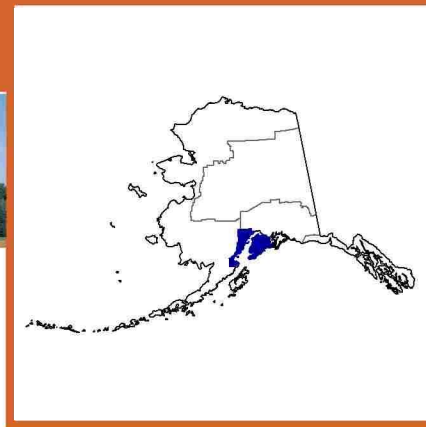


Kenai Peninsula Area, Alaska Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

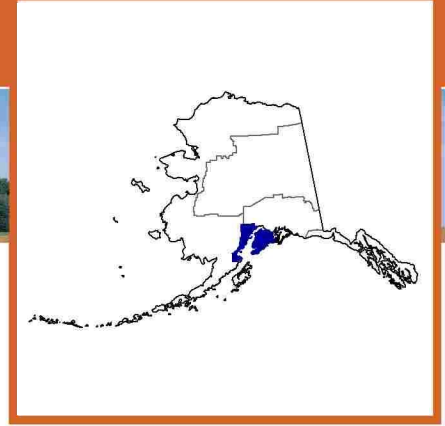

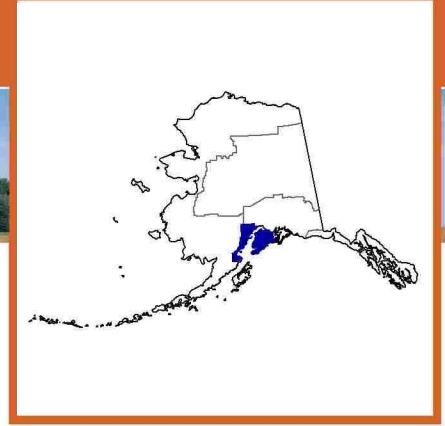

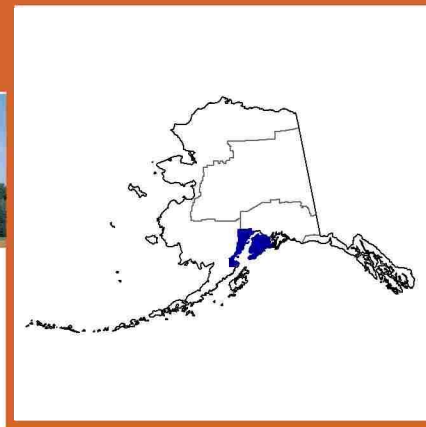

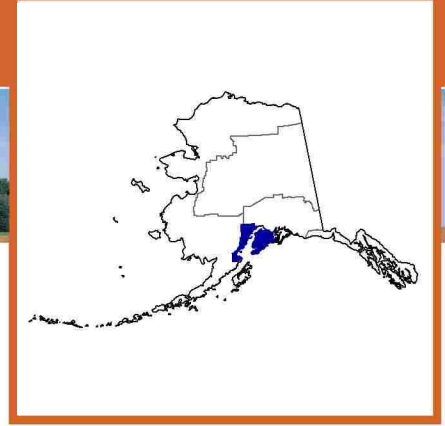

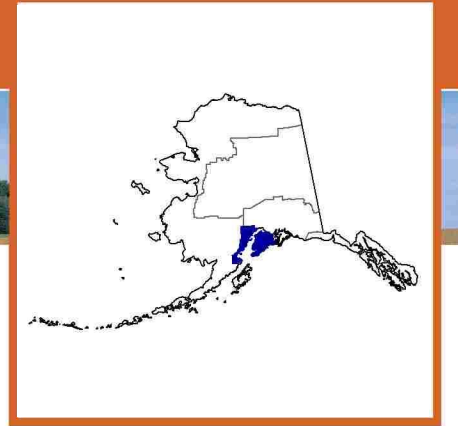
