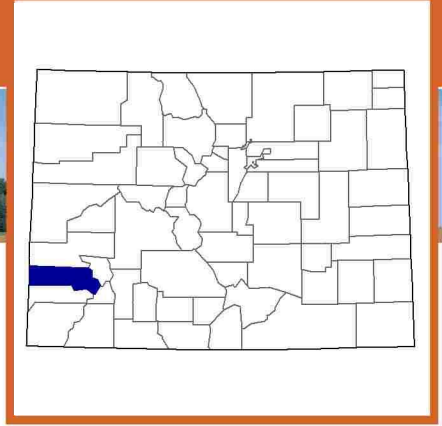

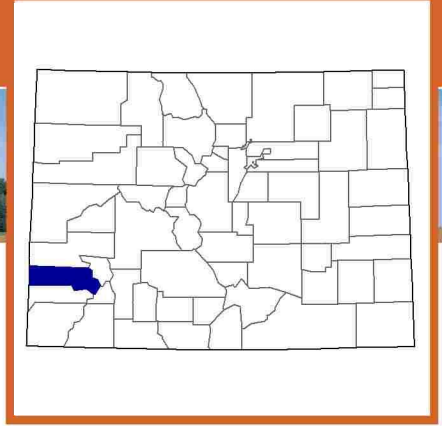
## San Miguel County, Colorado Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

## San Miguel County, Colorado Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

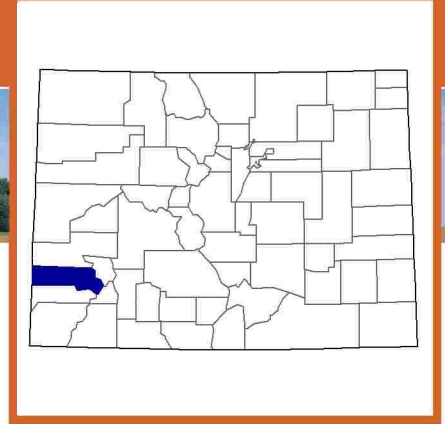

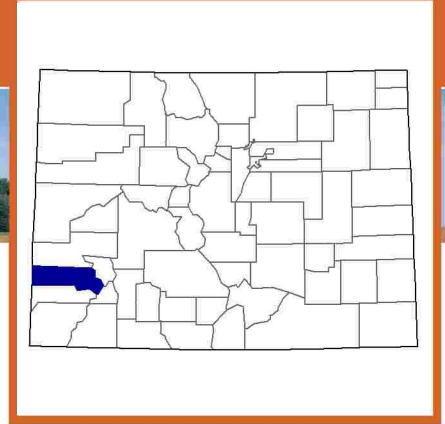

## San Miguel County, Colorado Farms with White Producers<sup>a</sup>



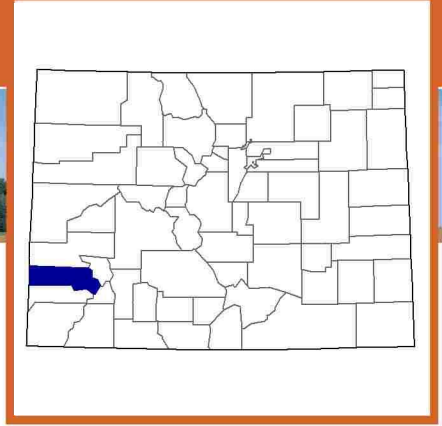

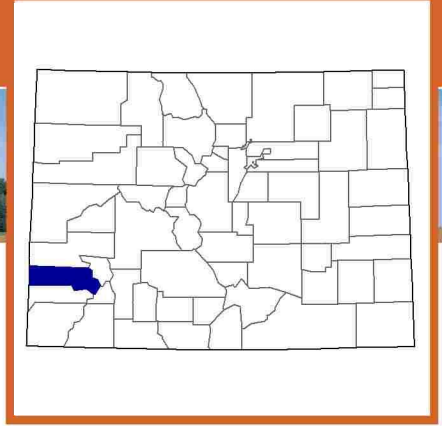


## San Miguel County, Colorado Farms with Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish Producers
