

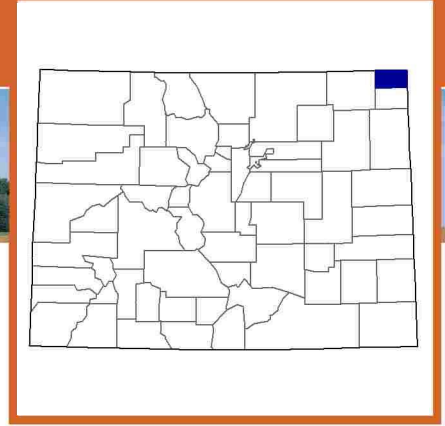

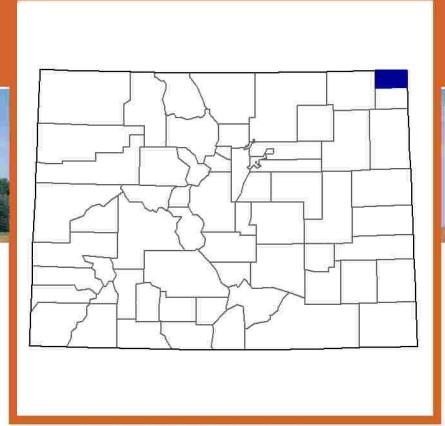


Sedgwick County, Colorado Farms with Asian Producers^a

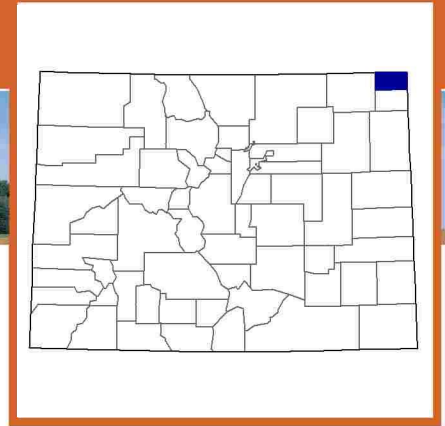

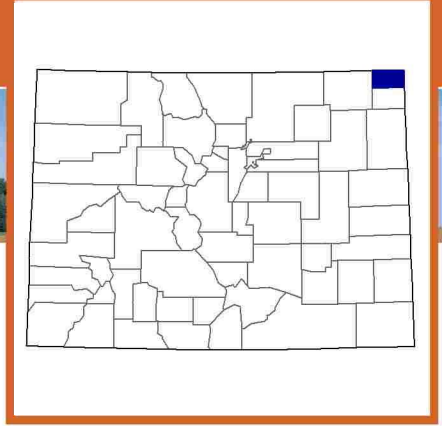

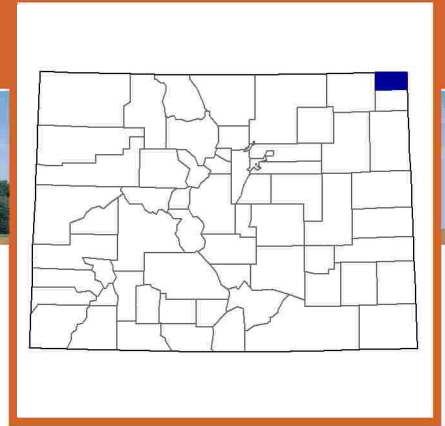


Sedgwick County, Colorado Farms with White Producers^a



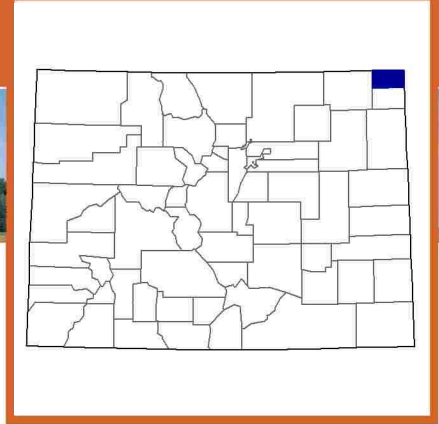
