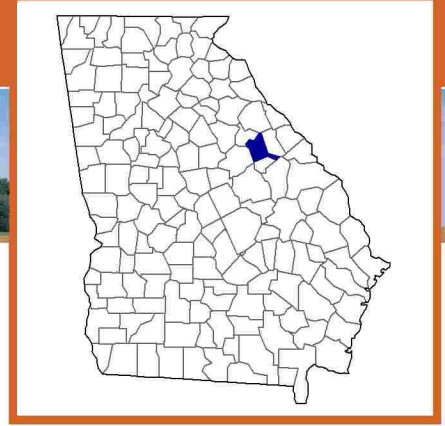


## Warren County, Georgia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

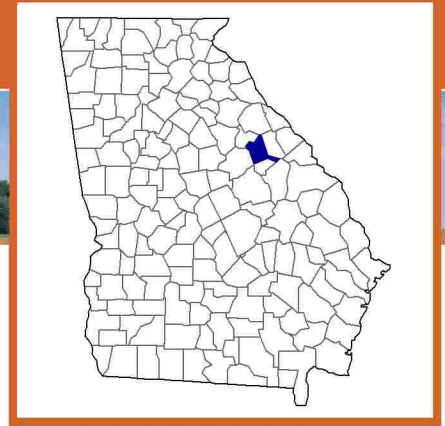


## Warren County, Georgia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

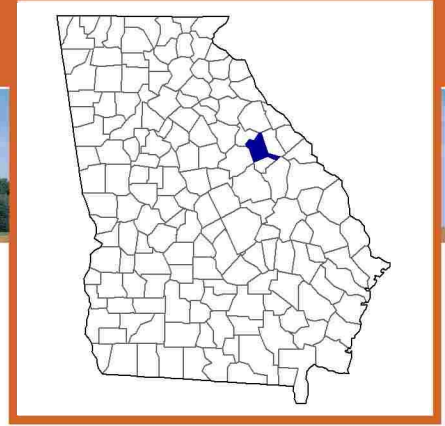


## Warren County, Georgia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

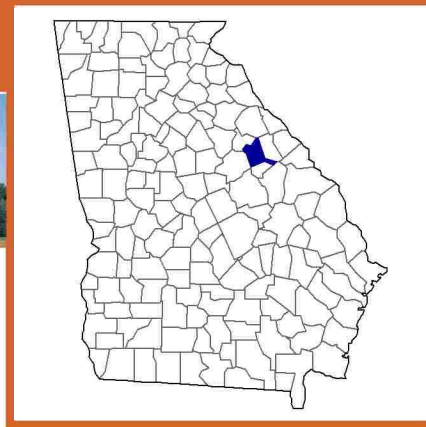

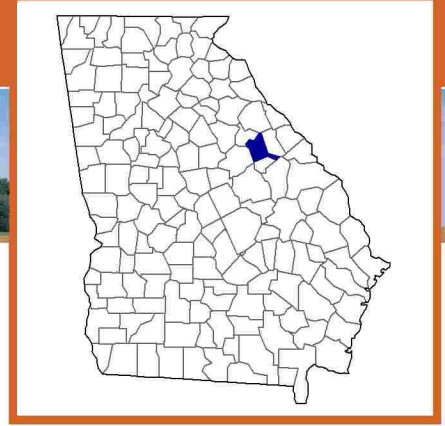

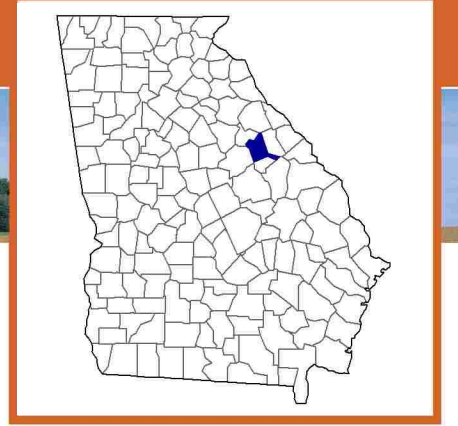
