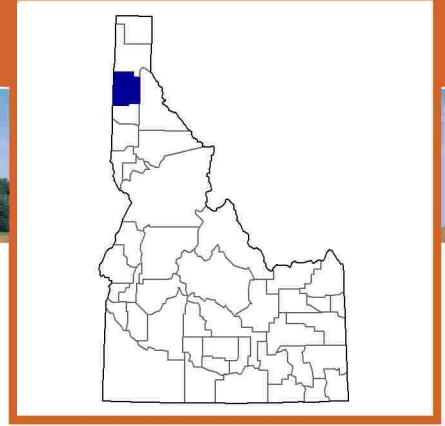

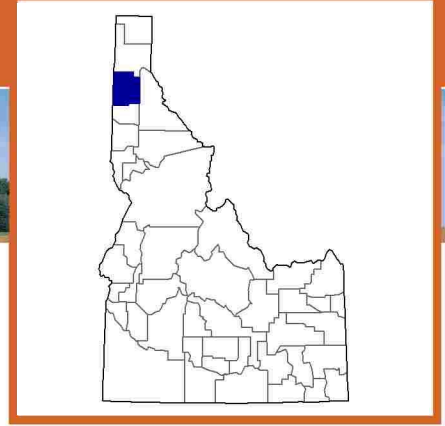


## Kootenai County, Idaho Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

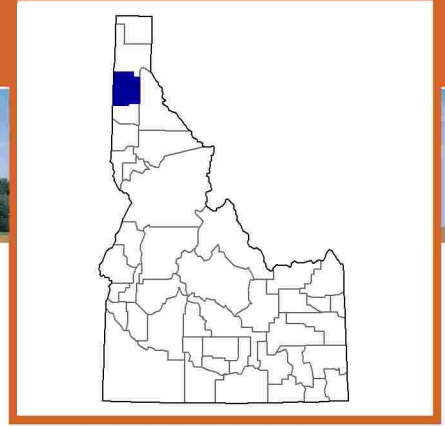

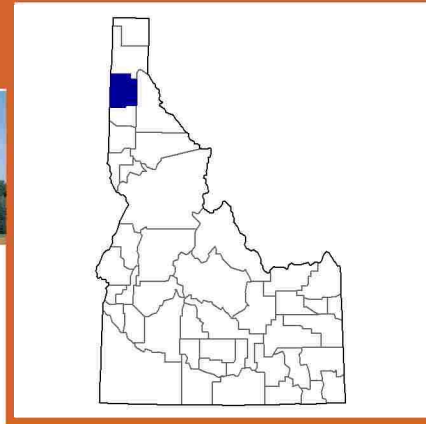

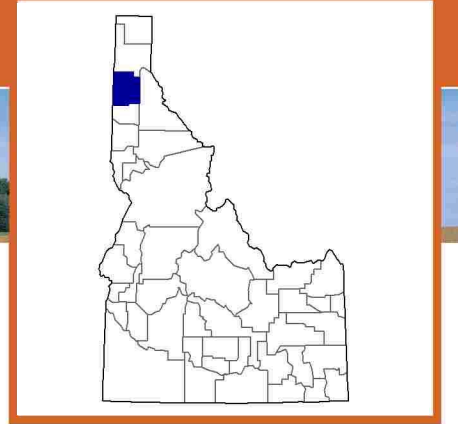
