

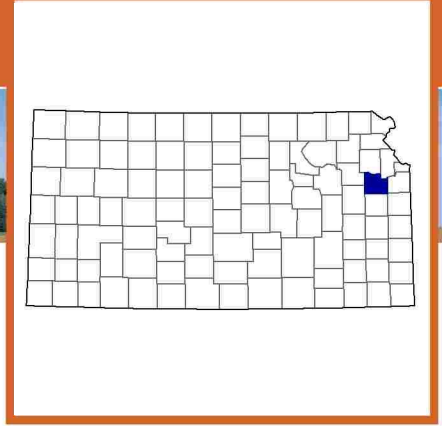


## Douglas County, Kansas Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

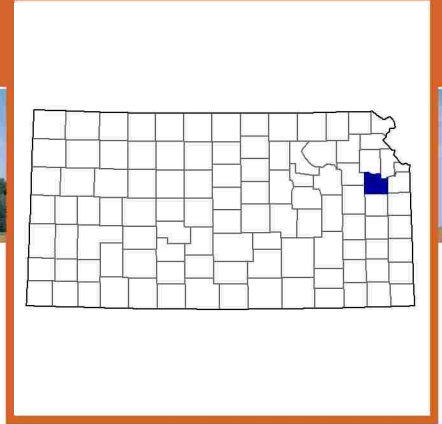

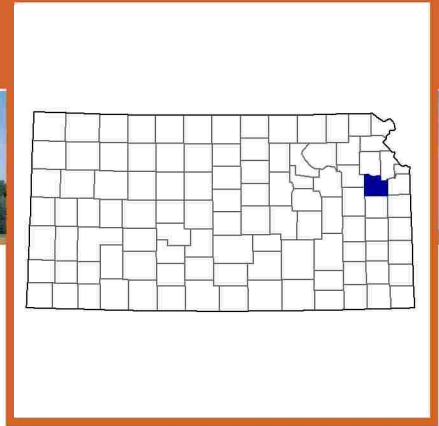

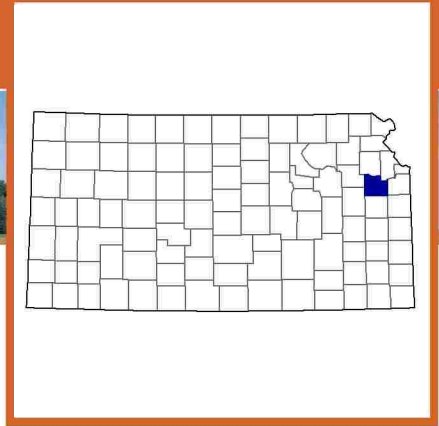
