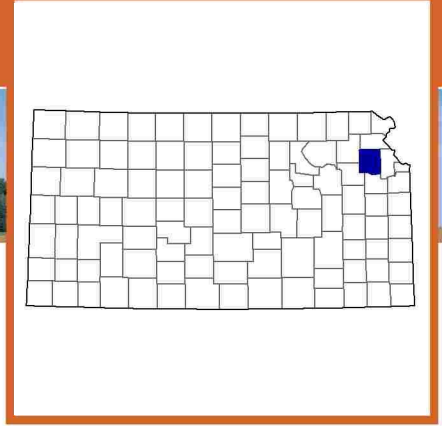

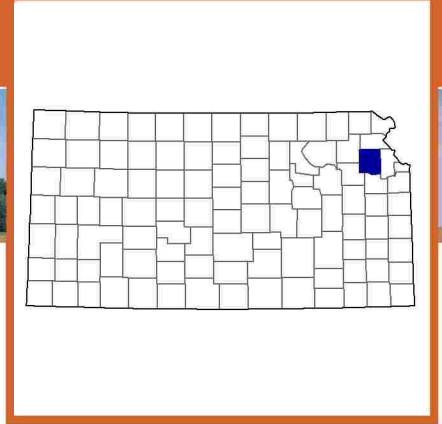

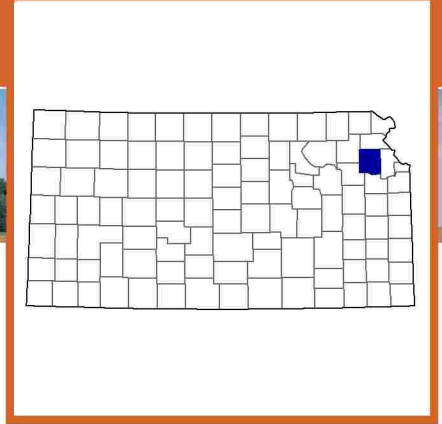

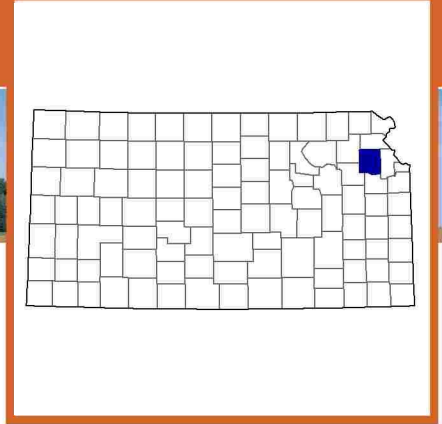

Jefferson County, Kansas Farms with White Producers^a

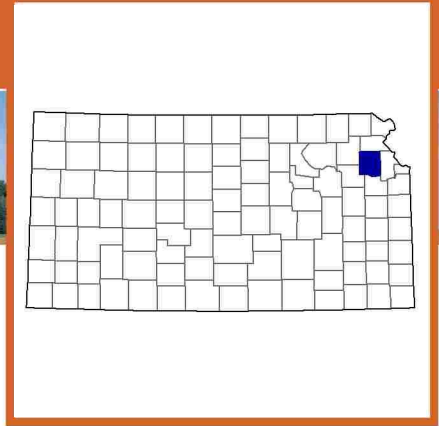
