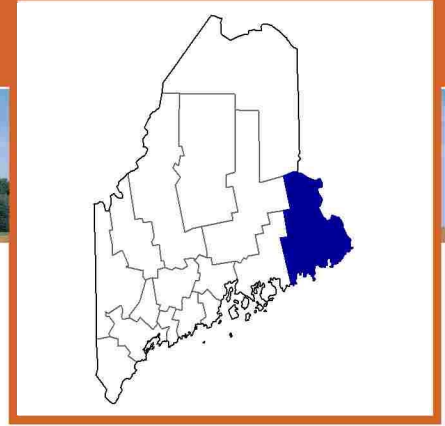


## Washington County, Maine Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

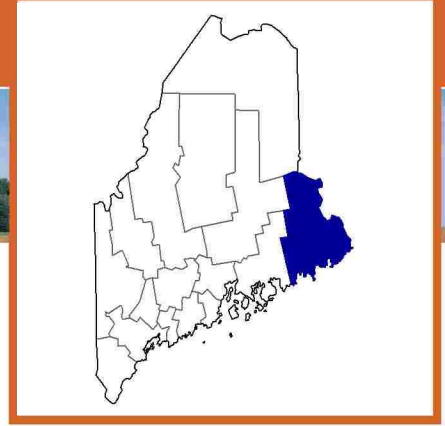


## Washington County, Maine Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

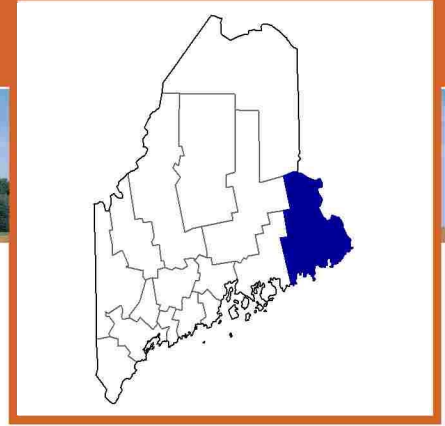

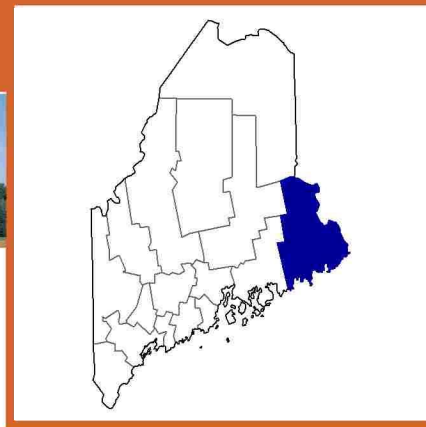

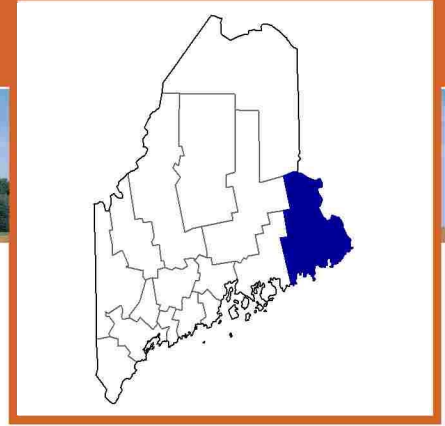

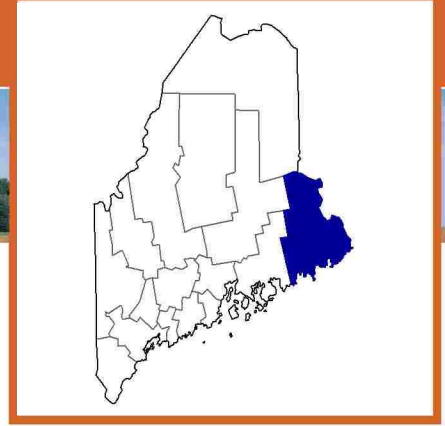
