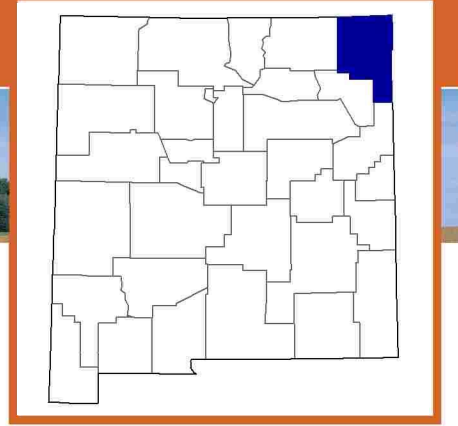

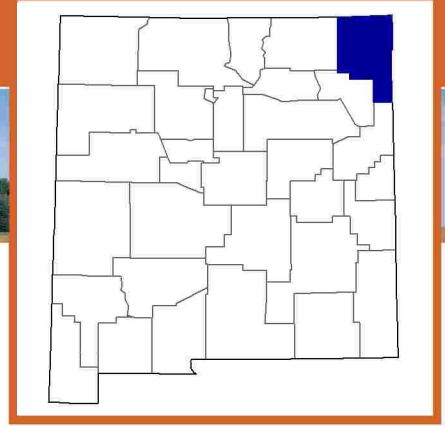
## Union County, New Mexico Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

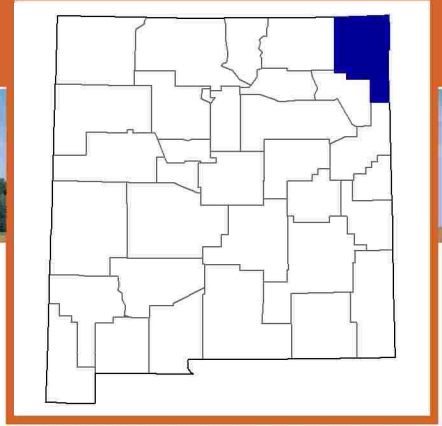

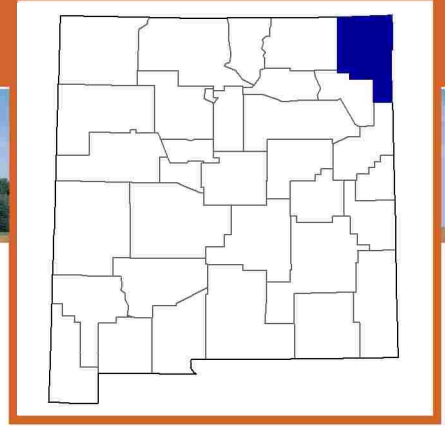

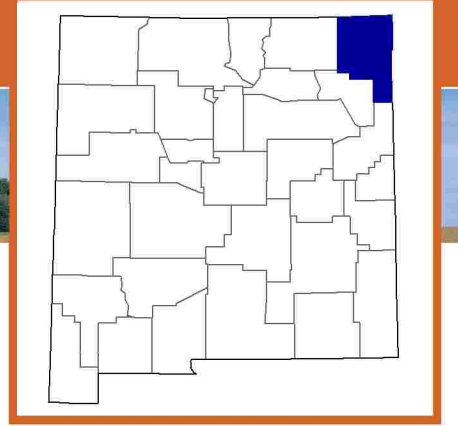
