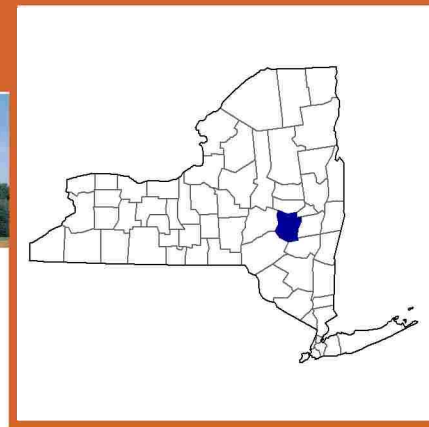

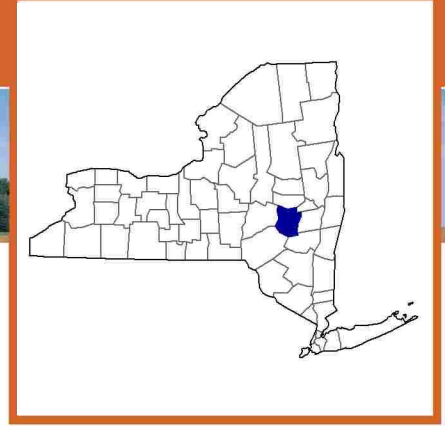


## Schoharie County, New York Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

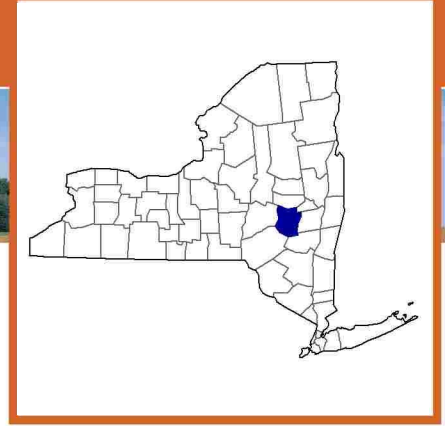

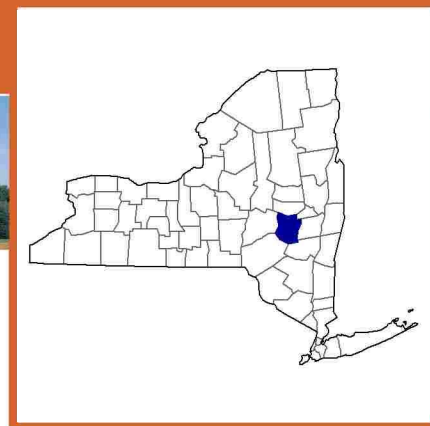

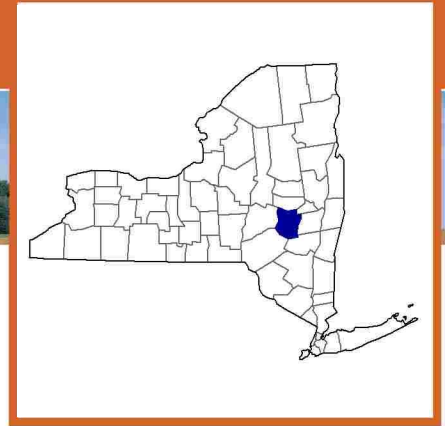
