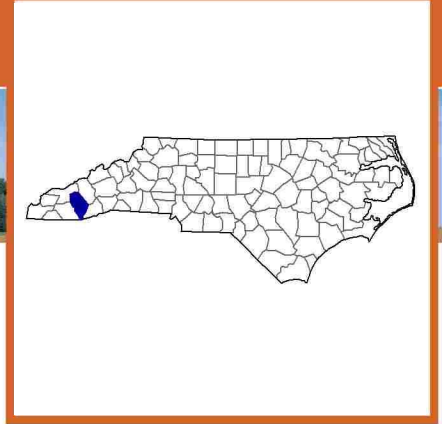

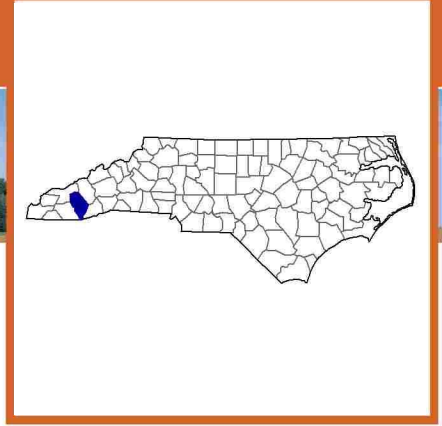


## Jackson County, North Carolina Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

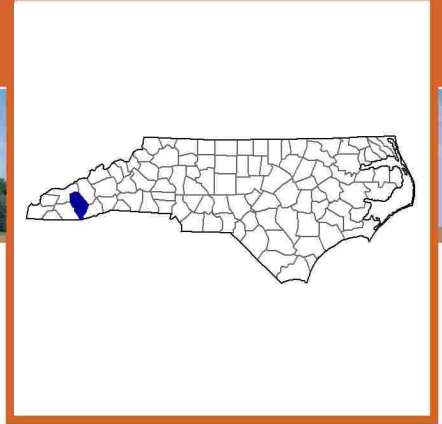

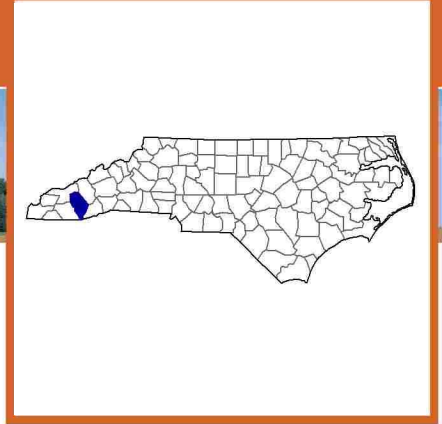

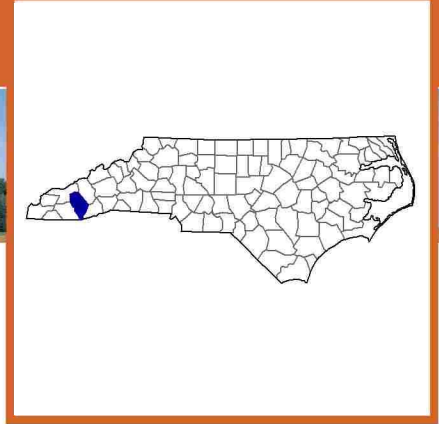
