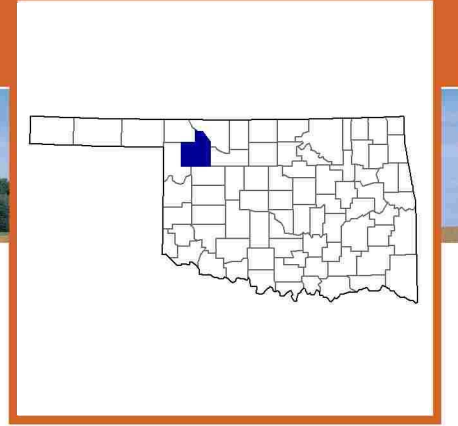

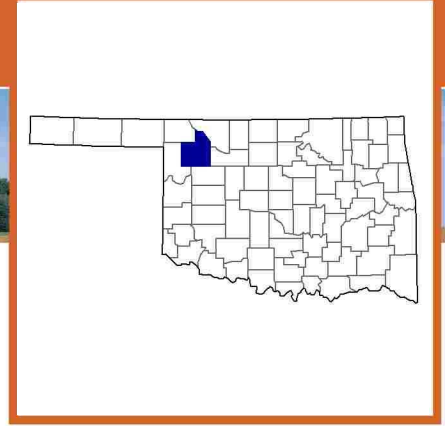


## Woodward County, Oklahoma Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

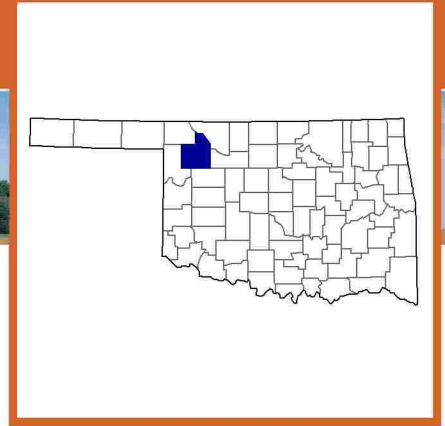


## Woodward County, Oklahoma Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

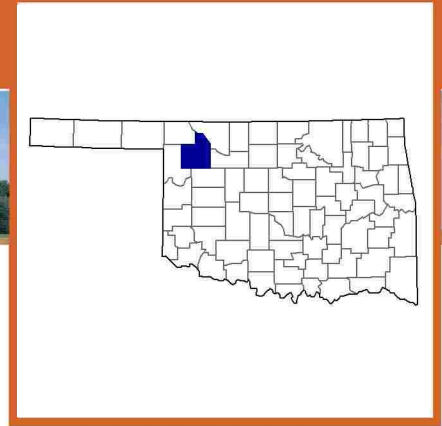

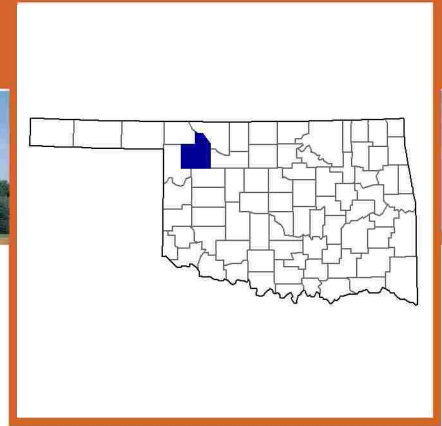

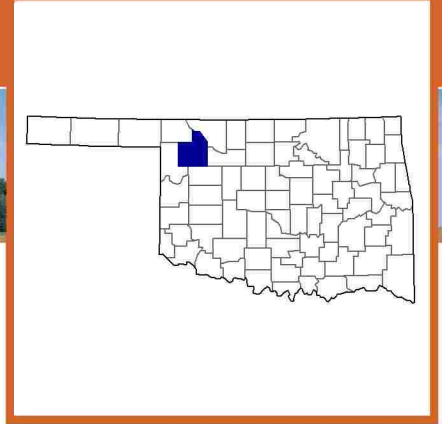
