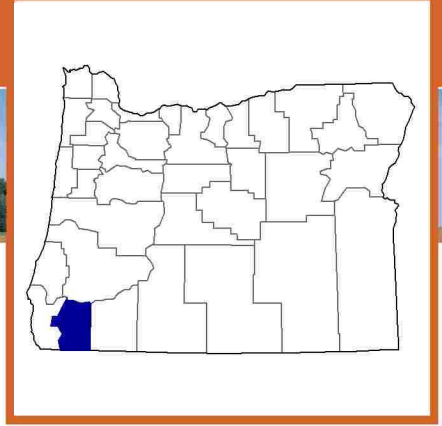

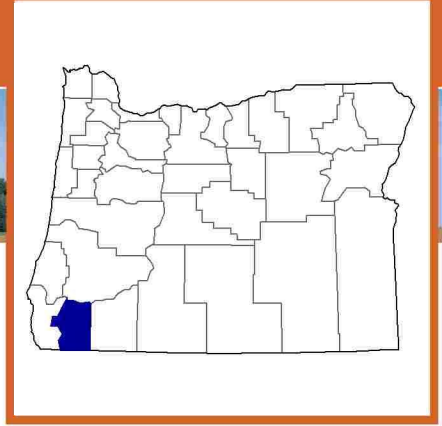


## Josephine County, Oregon Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

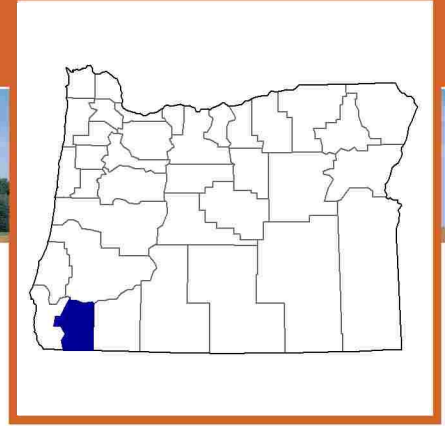

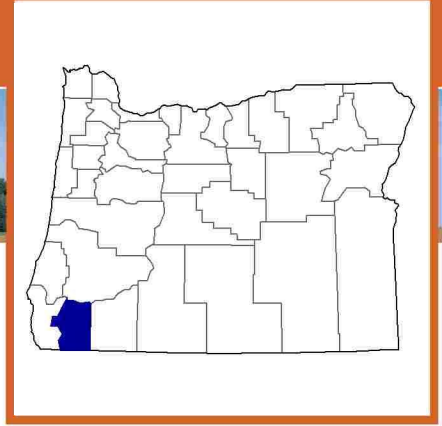

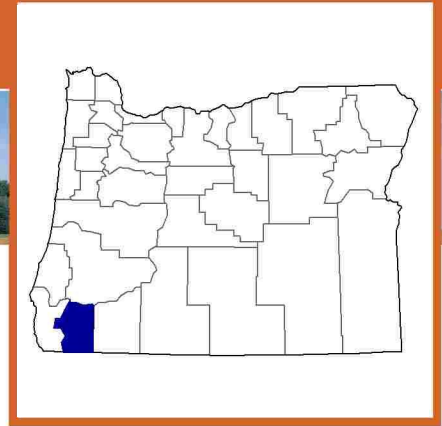
