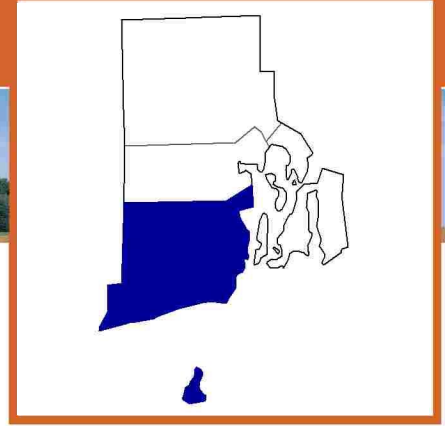


## Washington County, Rhode Island Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

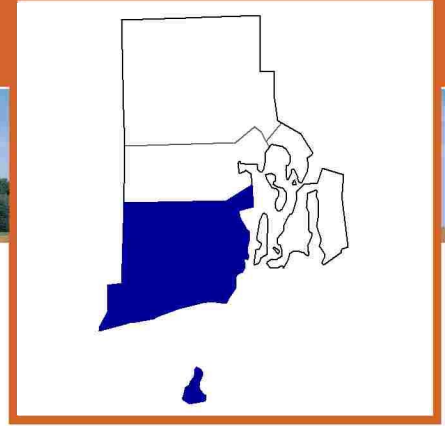


## Washington County, Rhode Island Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

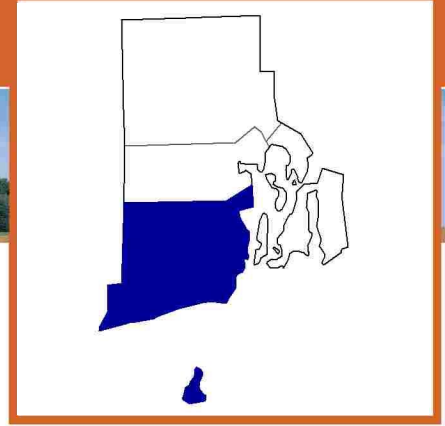


## Washington County, Rhode Island Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

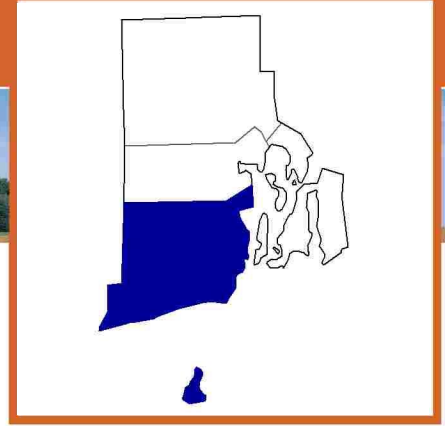

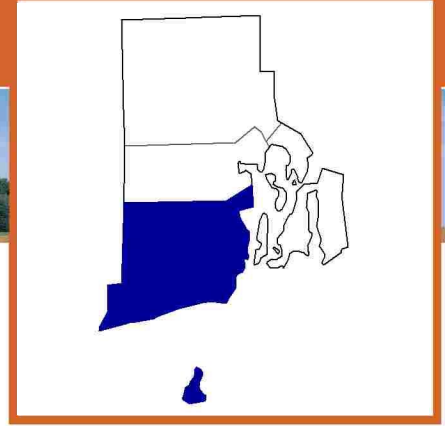

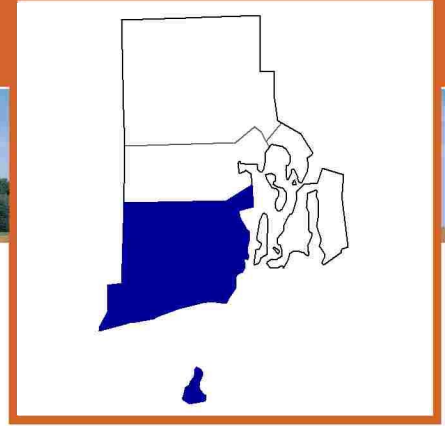
