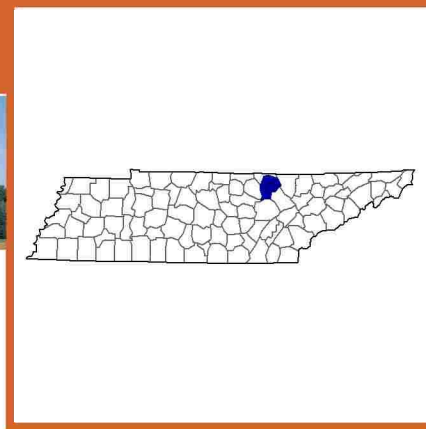

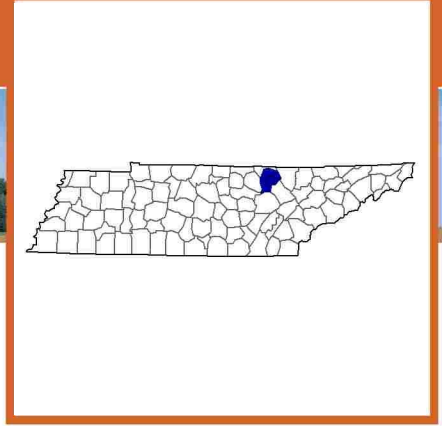


## Fentress County, Tennessee Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

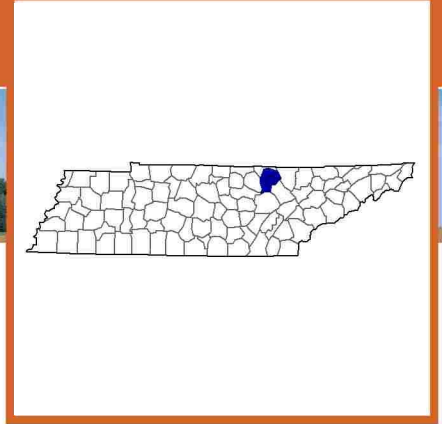


## Fentress County, Tennessee Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

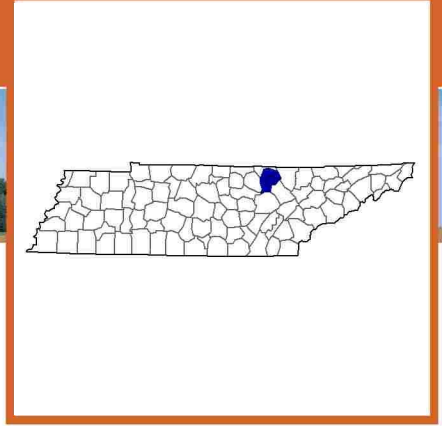

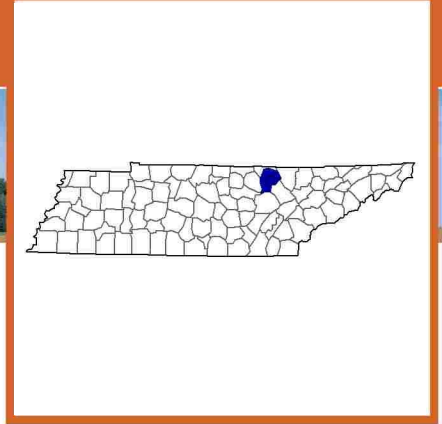

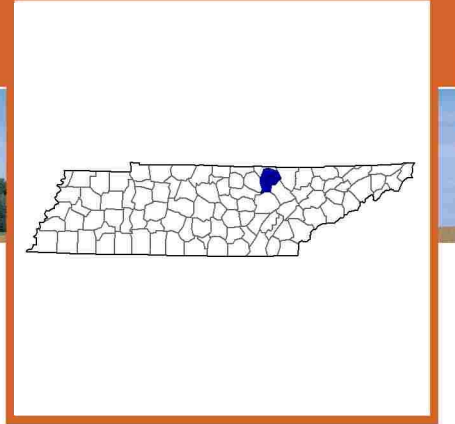
