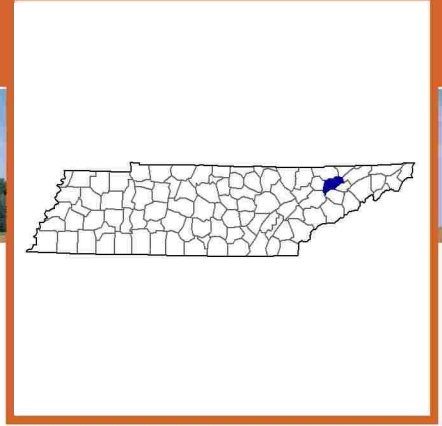


Grainger County, Tennessee Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

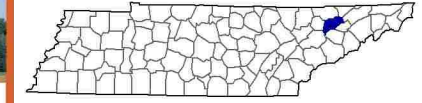

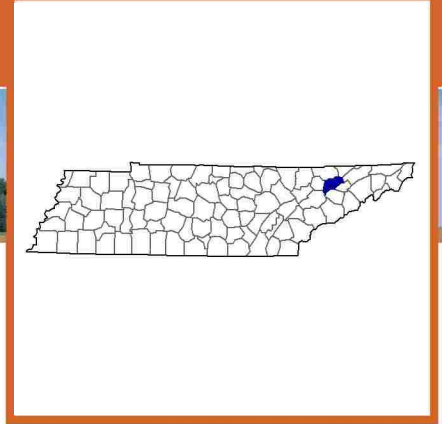

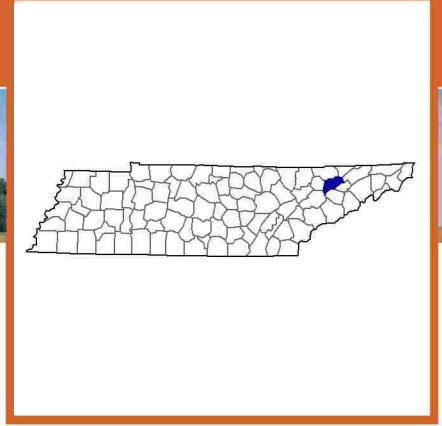

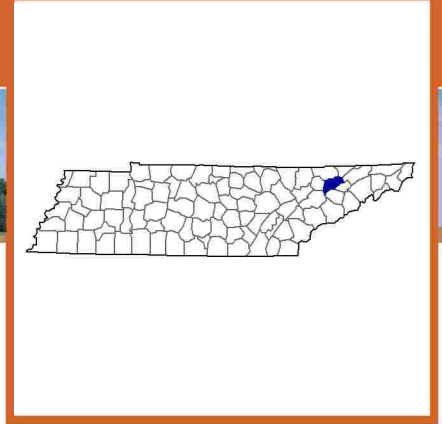

Grainger County, Tennessee Farms with White Producers^a

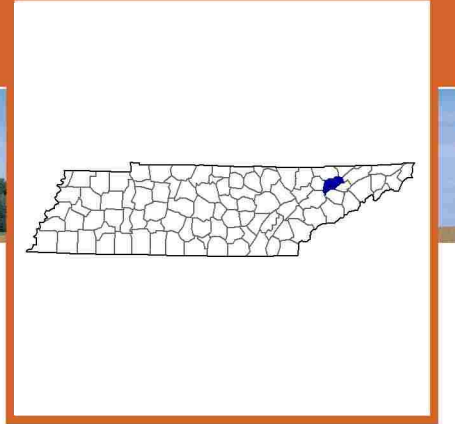
