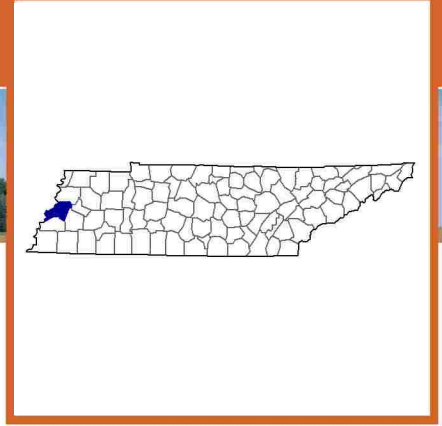

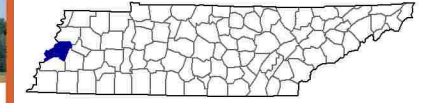


## Lauderdale County, Tennessee Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

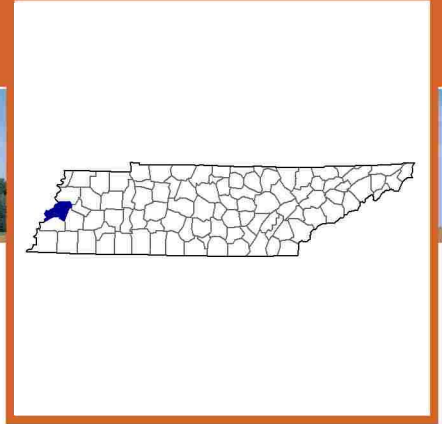

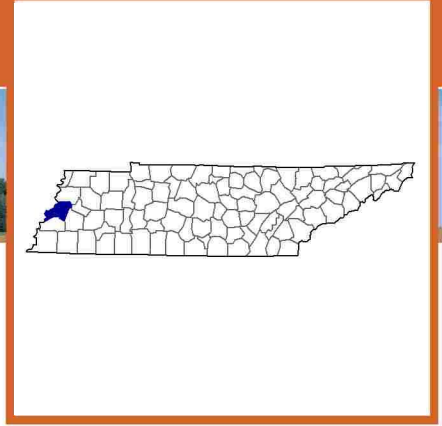

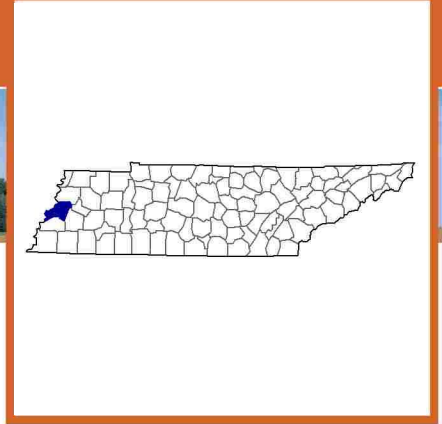

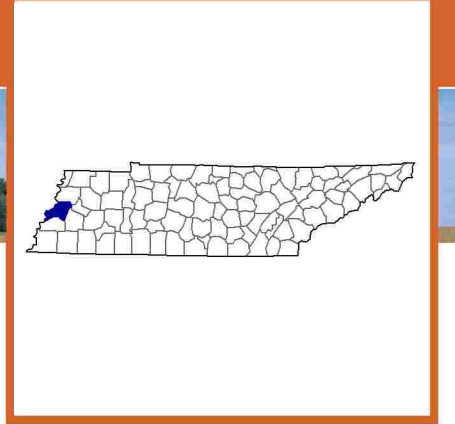
