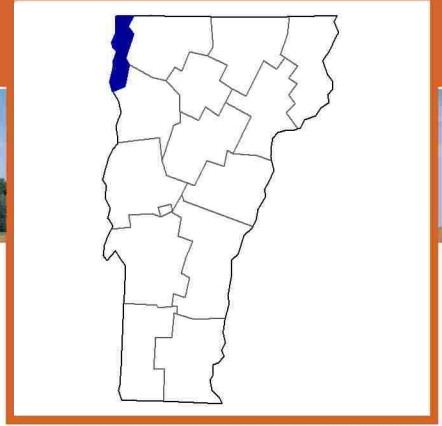


## Grand Isle County, Vermont Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

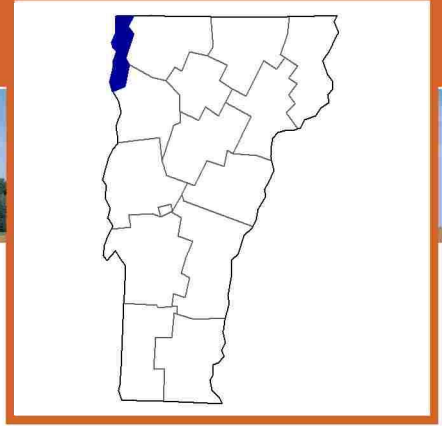


## Grand Isle County, Vermont Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

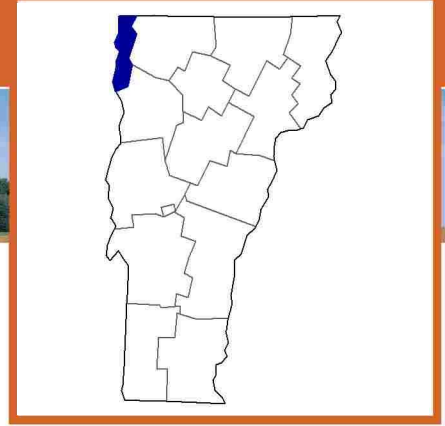


## Grand Isle County, Vermont Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

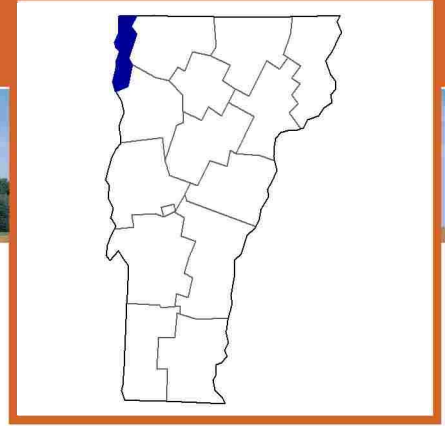

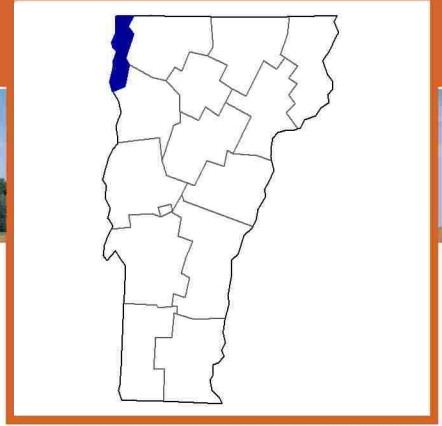

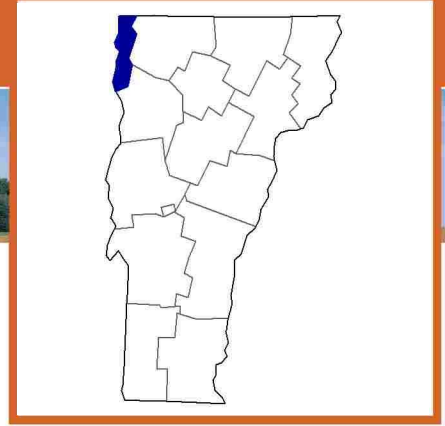
