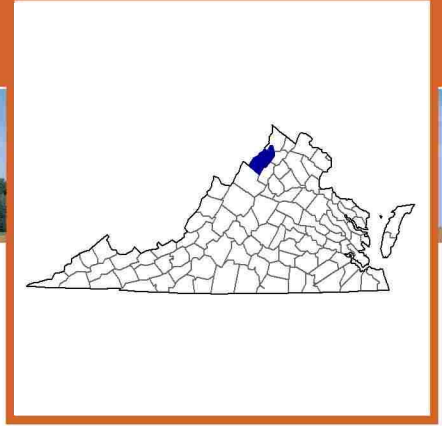


## Shenandoah County, Virginia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

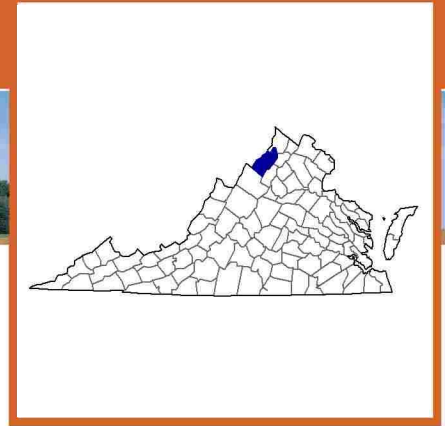


## Shenandoah County, Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

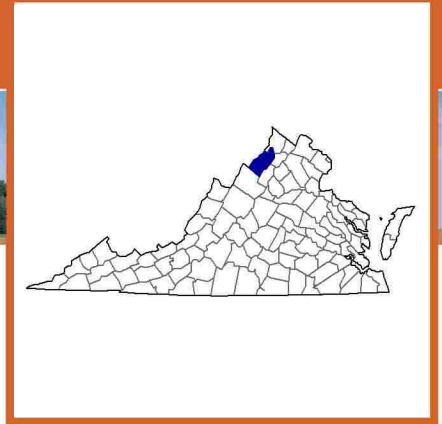


## Shenandoah County, Virginia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

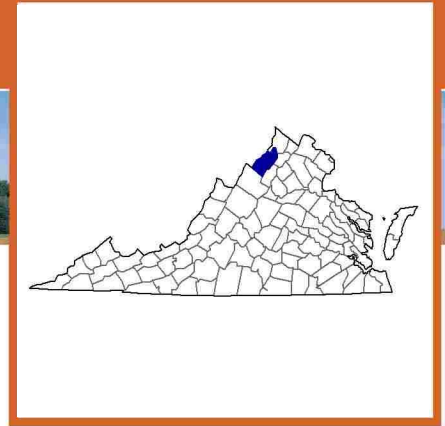

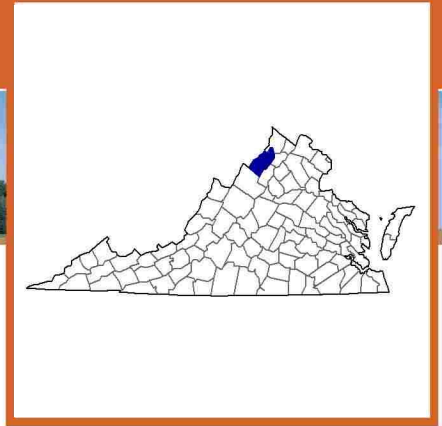
