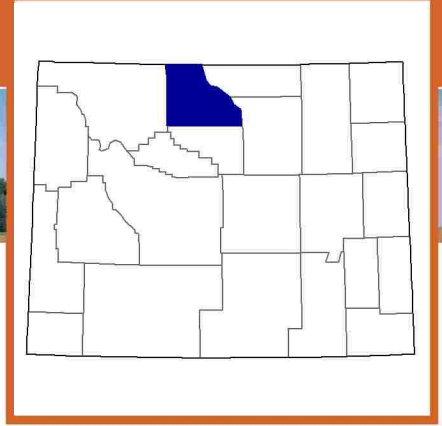

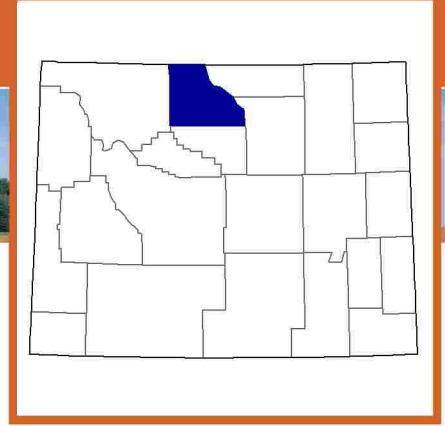


## Big Horn County, Wyoming Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

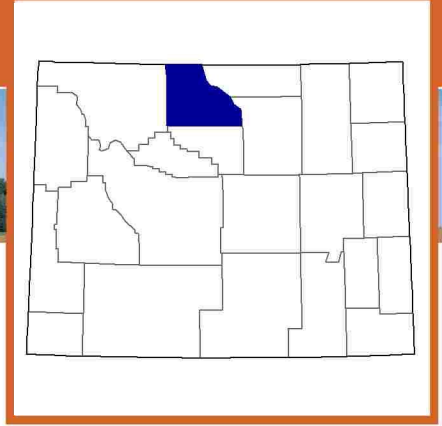


## Big Horn County, Wyoming Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

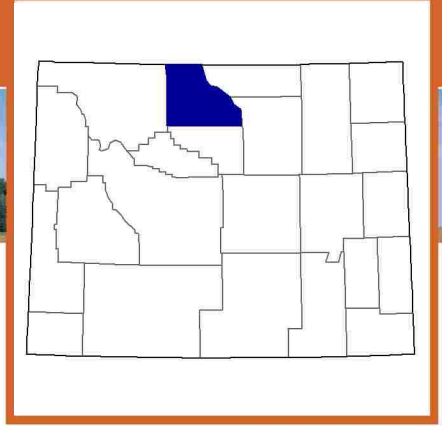

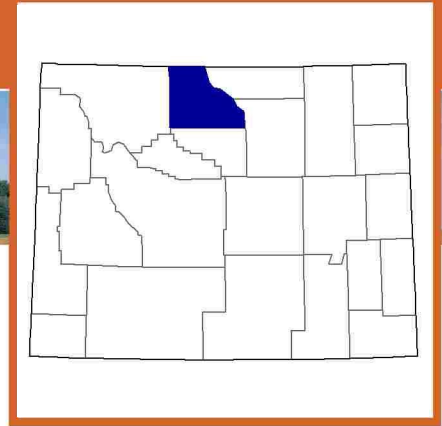

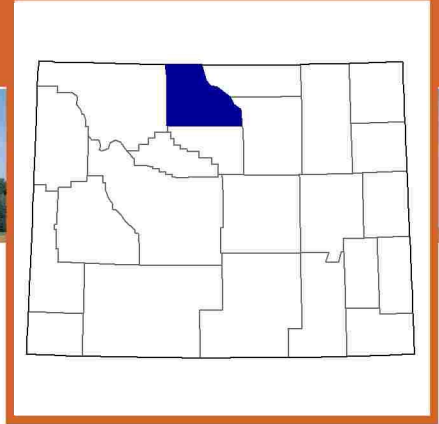
