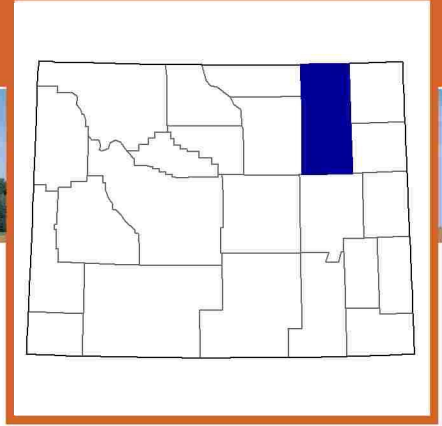

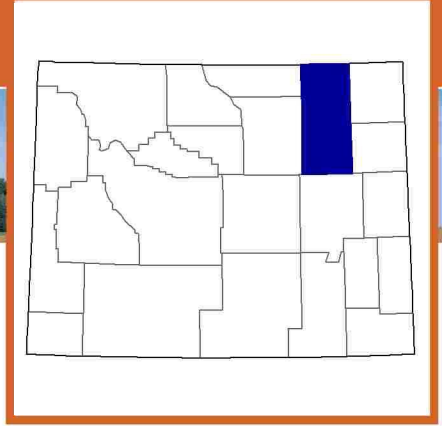
## Campbell County, Wyoming Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

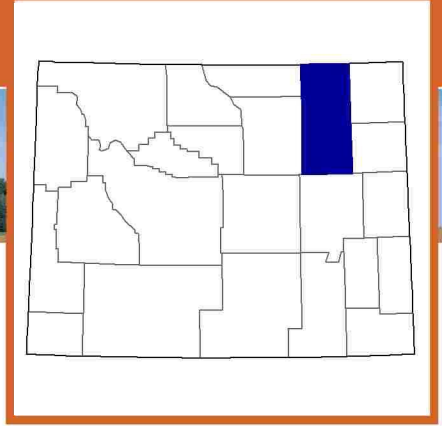


## Campbell County, Wyoming Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

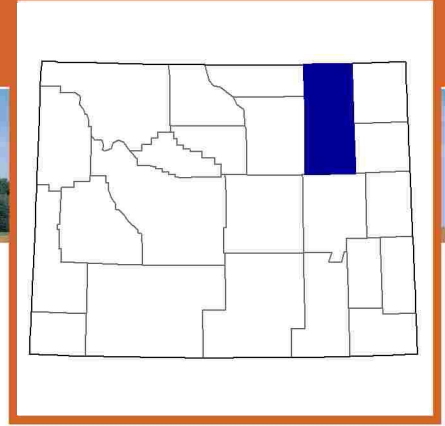

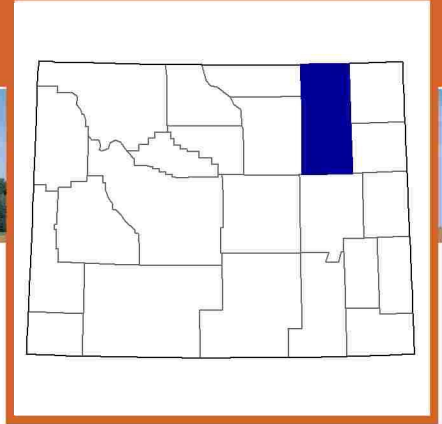

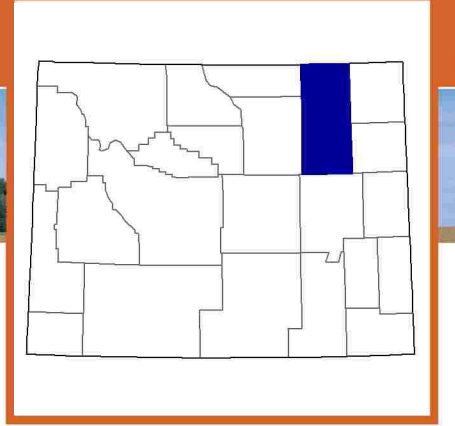
