

CHAPTER 146

BASIC SCIENCE ACT

146.06 EXAMINATIONS.

Limitation on right of board to extend period for re-examination for one who permitted his reexamination period to expire before he entered military service. OAG Feb. 10, 1946 (303-B).

It is for the board to determine whether or not the credentials submitted by the applicant make a showing sufficient and are equivalent to standards required by statute or by the rules of the board. OAG April 25, 1946 (303-B).

146.09 CERTIFICATES WITHOUT EXAMINATION TO PRACTITIONERS FROM OTHER STATES.

Reciprocal and retaliatory legislation. 21 MLR 371.

146.11 FEES; DISPOSITION OF, REPORTS.

Except where due to error of employees, fees may be refunded by legislative act and in no other way. OAG July 16, 1943 (196-M).

146.21 PROSECUTIONS; ALLEGATIONS AND PROOF NOT REQUIRED.

An information examined and found to charge practicing healing without a basic science certificate. Defendant was guilty of giving lectures, sale of tablets, and advice regarding use of tablets. The requirements of the act are germane to the protection of the public, and applicable to the acts charged against defendant. State v Mielke, 202 M 114, 277 NW 420.
