SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS. Persons interested in providing written comments on the proposed Order are encouraged to submit comments by electronic mail. Comment letters must be received by **5:00 p.m. on September 8, 2024**. Comment letters received after that deadline will not be accepted and will not be included in the administrative record absent a ruling by the Central Coast Water Board Chair. Any person requesting to submit late comments must demonstrate good cause for the late submission and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Coast Water Board or the Discharger. All interested persons and the Discharger may speak at the public meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral comments will be limited in time by the Chair.
