RESOLUTION R5-2017-0107
APPROVING THE LOCAL AGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM
FOR
SHASTA COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DIVISION

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2012, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) adopted Resolution No. 2012-0032, which in part approved the *Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems* (OWTS Policy);

WHEREAS, the OWTS Policy allows Local Agencies to propose Local Agency Management Programs (LAMPs) for Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) approval, as conditional waivers of waste discharge requirements;

WHEREAS, the OWTS Policy requires Central Valley Water Board staff (staff) to solicit comments from the State Water Board's Division of Drinking Water (DDW) regarding a LAMP's proposed setbacks and notifications to water purveyors;

WHEREAS, on 10 February 2016 the Shasta County Environmental Health Division (SCEHD) submitted an informal draft LAMP, along with a preliminary completeness checklist per staff's request;

WHEREAS on 13 March 2016 staff provided comments on the informal draft LAMP and checklist, and on 28 April 2016 SCEHD submitted a formal draft LAMP that addressed staff's comments;

WHEREAS, on 17 May 2016 staff sought DDW's comments on the formal draft, and on 15 September 2016 DDW concurred contingent on an appropriate workshop by 13 May 2018 to define public agency responsibilities and procedures for OWTS Policy implementation;

WHEREAS, on 27 July 2017 the Central Valley Water Board notified SCEHD and interested persons of its intent to approve the LAMP, and provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity to submit comments and recommendations on both the LAMP and checklist; and

WHEREAS, on 20 October 2017, the Central Valley Water Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this action:

Therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Central Valley Water Board hereby approves the Local Agency Management Program submitted by the Shasta County Environmental Health Division.
