NOTICE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND PUBLIC HEARING for DUNAVANT ENTERPRISES, INC., FOR MONITORING, CLOSURE, AND POST-CLOSURE MAINTENANCE FOR PRODUCERS COTTON OIL COMPANY FRESNO COUNTY

Enclosed are the tentative revised Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for the Producers Cotton Oil Company facility. Also enclosed is a Notice of Public Hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to §21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20005 et seq. (Title 27). The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.
