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TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. 85-109; MADERA COUNTY; MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 19, PARKWOOD WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; MADERA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order 85-109 for the Madera County (Discharger) Maintenance District #19, Parkwood Wastewater Treatment Facility in Madera County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering the adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 18 October 2024 meeting. Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted in writing to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 9 September 2024**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
