PUBLIC NOTICE FACT SHEET

London Ranch Shop 6889 Avenue 376, Dinuba, Tulare County Case No. T10000019862

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) invites public comment on its intent to issue a No Further Action determination (NFA) and closure to London Ranch Shop (Site) for completion of appropriate investigation and cleanup of petroleum hydrocarbons and related volatile organic compounds released to Site soil.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:

20 August 2024 – 19 September 2024

BACKGROUND

Site soils were impacted by an on-Site above ground storage tank (AST) system, which consisted of a 5,000-gallon diesel tank, a 5,000-gallon gasoline tank, an underground vapor recovery tank, underground product lines, and product dispensers.

Soil samples collected in 2022 indicated total petroleum hydrocarbons primarily in the diesel range (TPH-d) and fuel-related volatile organic compounds (VOCs) had impacted soil near the product dispensers.

In 2023, further investigation found that the release extended to a depth of approximately 45 feet below ground surface (bgs). Lateral extents were estimated to be limited to a diameter of approximately 50-feet surrounding the fuel dispenser and related underground piping. Based on the data from the investigation, groundwater quality beneath the Site (occurring at approximately 95-100 feet bgs) is not likely to be impacted.

A limited excavation to 15-feet bgs was performed in 2024 to remove impacted soil and reduce future human exposure health risks.

Remaining concentrations in Site soil are below regulatory limits provided in Table 1 of the California State Water Quality Control Board's Low-Threat Closure Policy for Underground Storage Tank Sites.

The Central Valley Water Board has concluded that residual constituents of concern in Site soil do not exceed regulatory thresholds or pose a significant threat to human health or the environment and is considering case closure. Once all public comments have been reviewed, the Central Valley Water Board will direct further corrective action or close the case, as appropriate.

Figure 1 – Site Location Map




Figure 1: Site Location 6889 Avenue 376, Dinuba, California
