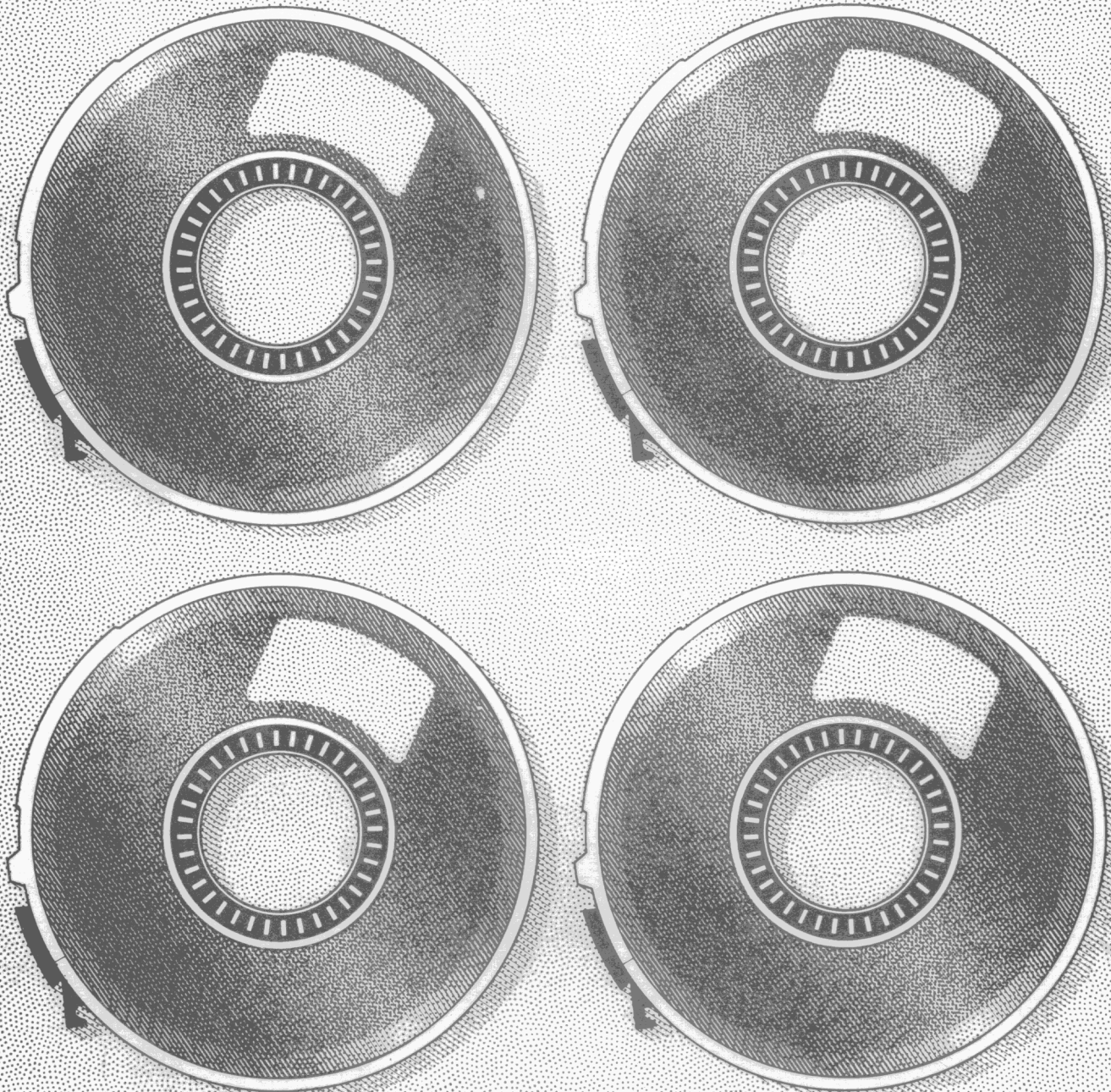

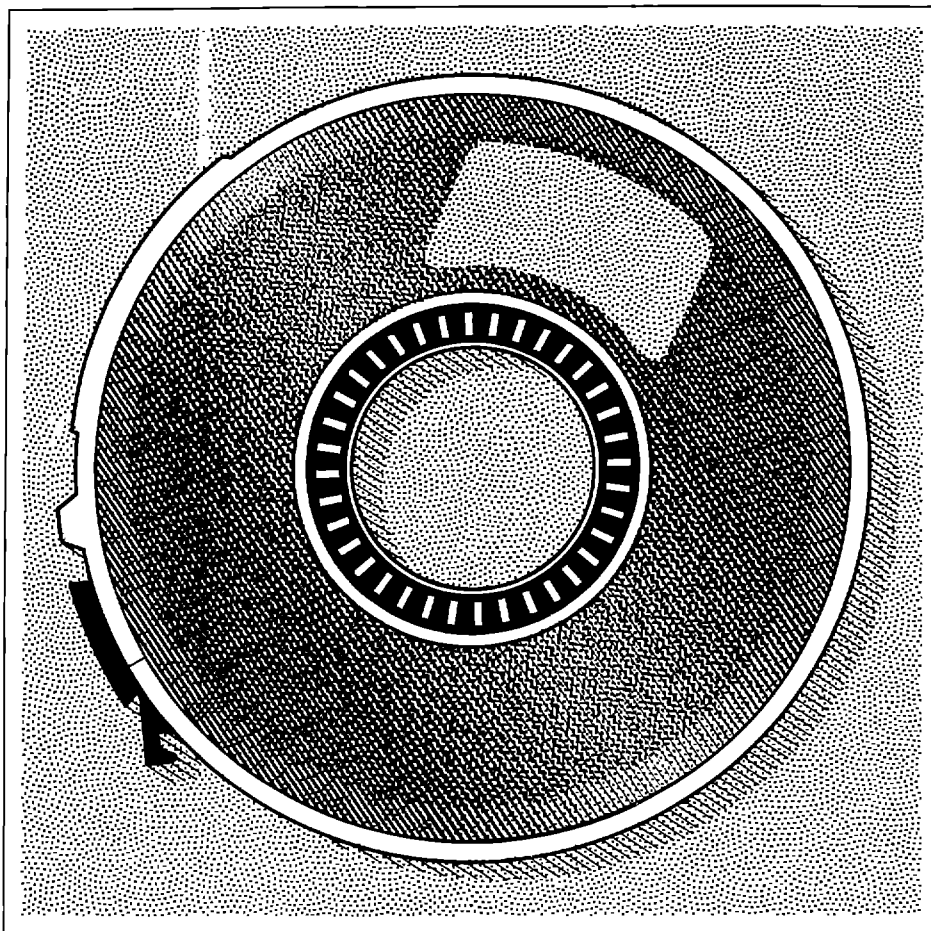

Cycle II Data

General Description. A detailed description of this Cycle is provided in the following report: National Center for Health Statistics: Plan, operation, and response results of a program of children's examinations. Vital and Health Statistics. PHS Pub. No. 1000-Series 1-No. 5 Public Health Service. Washington. U.S. Government Printing Office, Oct. 1967.

Coverage. The second cycle of the Health Examination Survey was conducted on a nationwide probability sample of 7,417 children from the noninstitutionalized population of the United States, excluding Hawaii and Alaska, aged 6-11. The survey started in July 1963 and was completed in December 1965. Out of the 7,417 children selected for the sample, 7,119 (96 percent) were examined. This national sample is representative of the roughly 24 million children in the population at that time.

Data Collection. Information was obtained for each examined child by means of detailed structured questionnaires for medical and developmental histories from a household adult, usually the mother; a school questionnaire; medical, dental and psychological examinations; vision and hearing tests; and anthropometric measurements.

Data Compilation. The major data elements obtained and derived from this survey have been compiled into one Integrated Data Tape (IDT) file which is available for release.

E. SCHOOL QUESTIONNAIRE

F. PSYCHOLOGICAL EXAMINATION

Five tests were given (WISC - Vocabulary and Block Designs; WRAT - Reading and Arithmetic; Draw-a-Person) with test qualifications noted; handedness and foreign language noted; several different standard deviation and normalized scores are provided ADDENDA - Strata, Pseudo Primary Sampling Unit (PPSU)

Temperature, pulse, general appearance (i.e., tics, nail biting), eyes, blood pressure, heart examination.

H. EAR, NOSE, AND THROAT EXAMINATION

Thirteen ear conditions were noted for both ears; nine nose and six throat conditions were also noted.

I. DIAGNOSTIC IMPRESSIONS

Ten diagnostic impressions were recorded (i.e., overall, injuries, heart, neurological).

J. AUDIOMETRY - HEARING

Decibel levels at nine c.p.s. levels, for each ear.

K. VISION

Color vision, near and distance acuity (each eye), and phoria.

L. DENTAL EXAMINATION

Number of primary and permanent teeth decayed, missing, filled, and present; gingivitis and periodontal pockets; periodontal debris, calculus, oral hygiene, and orthodontic treatment priority indexes; malocclusion syndrome; buccal segment relations; posterior cross-bites; incisor vertical relationship; malaligned teeth; mandibular protrusion; overjet; overbite; openbite; orthodontic appliances.

M. BODY MEASUREMENTS

Thirteen sitting measurements and thirteen standing measurements, three skinfold measures, height, weight, grip strength, and handedness.

N. BONE AGE

Assessments of skeletal maturation from hand-wrist x-rays.
